**UNWTO COMMISSION FOR AFRICA****Fifty-first meeting****Introduction**

1. The opening ceremony of the fifty-first meeting of the UNWTO Commission for Africa (CAF), which was held on 6 June 2011 in Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso, was presided by His Excellency Mr. Luc Adolphe Tiao, Prime Minister and Head of Government of Burkina Faso. The meeting, which was attended by more than 200 delegates from the twenty-nine countries of the region, was followed by a regional seminar on "How Sustainable Tourism can benefit from and contribute to an emerging Green Economy in Africa" held on 7 June 2011.

2. Representing the Mayor of Ouagadougou, Mr. Jean Christophe Ilboudo, welcomed the participants, wished them all a pleasant stay in Ouagadougou, and invited them to explore the city and enjoy the local hospitality. Mr. Ilboudo shared with the participants the tourism features of Ouagadougou, highlighting its internationally known cultural festivals.

3. Speaking in his capacity as the Chairman of the UNWTO Commission for Africa, H.E. El Hadj Baba Hamadou, Minister of Tourism of Cameroon, started by thanking His Excellency Mr. Blaise Compaoré, President of the Republic of Burkina Faso, and the people of Burkina Faso for the warm welcome received. The Chairman emphasized the importance of tourism in Africa; recognized the great work done by South Africa in promoting Africa as a tourism destination through the 2010 FIFA World Cup it organized successfully; and called the members to make tourism an effective tool to fight against poverty and promote development in Africa.

4. Addressing the participants, Mr. Soumaïla Cissé, President of the UEMOA Commission, highlighted the importance of tourism for all the UEMOA member states, and said that one of the main objectives of his organization was to promote a regional, integrated and competitive tourism market. Mr. Cissé also reiterated the importance of the cooperation agreement between UNWTO and UEMOA for the benefit of the region.

5. In his speech, Mr. Taleb Rifai, UNWTO Secretary-General, expressed his satisfaction for the importance that the Government of Burkina Faso placed in the tourism, as a sector to diversify the national economy. He thanked H.E. Baba Hama, Minister of Culture and Tourism in Burkina Faso, and recalled the key role the country plays as Vice-Chair of the UNWTO Commission for Africa, and Member of the Executive Council.

6. Mr. Rifai emphasized the importance of regional cooperation for the development of tourism; shared with the participants some of the results of tourism in the year 2010, and stressed the need to understand tourism as a key sector for socio-economic development in Africa and worldwide.

7. In his official opening speech, H.E. Baba Hama, Minister of Culture and Tourism of Burkina Faso, and CAF Vice-Chair, welcomed the participants on behalf of the Prime Minister and on his behalf. The Minister spoke about the tourism potential of Burkina Faso, and reassured the importance that the Government accords to the sector. He went on by stressing the close cooperation between UNWTO and Burkina Faso, and also emphasized the fundamental role of regional cooperation in the sector.

**COMMUNICATION OF THE CHAIRMAN

9. In his communication, H.E. El Hadj Baba Hamadou, Minister of Tourism of Cameroon and Chairman of the UNWTO Commission for Africa, expressed the Commission's gratitude to the Government of Burkina Faso for inviting its members to meet in Ouagadougou, and thanked the authorities and the people of Burkina Faso for the warm welcome and hospitality awarded to the participants.

10. The Chairman highlighted the enormous tourism potential of the region and called the Members to actively work for its development. He recognized the progress of the African destinations in the last years, and emphasized the importance of a more dynamic regional cooperation for the benefit of the tourism sector. The Chairman thanked the international and regional organizations that have been assisting Africa in the development of the tourism sector, and especially the UNWTO for the continuous support.

11. The Chairman recalled the importance of the UNWTO regional initiatives in Africa, such as the West Africa Parks Project, the CEMAC Ministerial tourism initiative, the capacity building programme on tourism statistics in English speaking African countries, the INVESTOUR initiative, and encouraged the Secretariat to continue to work in this direction.

12. The Commission acknowledged the UNWTO Secretary-General efforts to promote tourism development in the region, and congratulated him for the job well done.

**PRELIMINARY REMARKS OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL**

The Secretary-General started his Preliminary Remarks by presenting to the Commission the international tourism results in 2010 and prospects for 2011, with emphasis to the Africa region where the positive trends continue. He went on to inform the Commission about the Global Leaders of Tourism Campaign, an initiative aiming at mainstreaming tourism in global agenda, and presented the implementation progress of the Programme of Work 2010/2011 both at global level and in Africa in particular. The Secretary-General finalized his remarks by presenting the report of the financial situation of the Organization for 2010/2011 and informed the Commission about the progress of the Secretariat's restructuring process.

14. The Commission,

Having heard with interest the preliminary remarks of the Secretary-General;

- Notes with satisfaction the positive trends of tourism worldwide and in the region, considering the difficult economic and financial situation the world is living;
  - Applauds the Secretary-General for the Global Tourism Leaders Campaign aiming to promote and position the tourism sector at a higher level in the global priorities, and reiterates its support for the successful implementation of this initiative;
  - Congratulates the Secretary-General and the Secretariat for successful implementation of the Programme of Work in the region;
  - Congratulates the Secretary-General for signing cooperation agreements with sub-regional organizations such as the latest concluded with RETOSA and UEMOA, for promoting sustainable tourism development through programmes and initiatives corresponding to the specific needs of their member states.
  - Notes with satisfaction the efforts of the Secretariat for the rationalization and consolidation of expenditure, resulting in higher levels of Programme of Work delivery within the context of a "zero growth" budget for the Organization;
  - Reiterates its support to the Secretary-General in the process of the modernization of the Secretariat.
