

COVID-19 Protocols

Georgia has introduced Mandatory Safety Guidelines for the tourism sector of the country. Strict health and safety protocols are in place for airports and land borders, hotels, restaurants and cafes, transport, travel companies, and guides. The standards implemented ensure the safety of international visitors and local populations alike. The Government of Georgia will take all necessary measures to prevent and respond promptly and effectively to public health risks and public health emergencies of international concern.

Conditions of entry for the participants of the 112th Session of the UNWTO Executive Council:

- Thermal screening
- SARS-CoV-2 PCR diagnostic method at the airport (free of charge)

SARS-CoV-2 PCR diagnostic testing will be conducted at the airport, in compliance with all epidemiological requirements in a specially allocated area. The average time allotted for one person to test is 15 minutes.

If any delegate develops symptoms indicative of COVID-19, the 112 emergency response centre will be notified immediately. Timely emergency service will be provided at the airport and event venues.

In case of infection, the expenses of treatment at the designated hospital will be covered by the Government of Georgia.

Public health restrictions:

Wearing a face mask is compulsory in

- Public transport and taxis
- Elevators and shopping malls
- Reception areas of public and private entities
- Meetings at public or private entities, where maintaining the 2-metre social distance is impossible
- General, vocational and higher and vocational education institutions
- Beauty parlours and aesthetic medicine centres
