
The FIM is represented in 113 countries by its affiliated members and:

- Support to seniors;

Bulgaria

Czech Republic

- Donation of mobile homes for medical staff;
- Distribution of facemasks and respirators.

Turkey

 Delivery of medicines, masks, sanitizing gel, food etc.

Indonesia

- Distribution of protective devices for medical staff.

- Distribution of masks and food in remote areas.









Nepal

 Distribution of 2.500 basic items to homeless persons.

Philippines

 Donation of 15.000 protective kits in remote areas.

El Salvador

 Distribution of 35.000 protective kits and food items in remote areas.
