Mailed out to all Member States (MS) and presented through various fora including webinars and Regional Commission Meetings, interest in the TA package poured in and received 25 requests from MS\* and 7 Donor Organizations

# The Package is structured around three main pillars:

- 1) Economic Recovery
- 2) Marketing and Promotion
- 3) Institutional Strengthening and Building Resilience



# **OBJECTIVES OF THE THREE PILLARS**

- 1. Quantify and Qualify the impact of Covid-19 on the tourism sector of Member States and provide strategic recommendations to stimulate economic recovery through tourism and support tourism **MSMEs**
- 2. Develop targeted marketing and promotion strategies based on the unique characteristics of each Member State and **Destination**
- Strengthen capacities of institutions and private sector to adopt and adapt protocols for provision of tourism services in a new, post Covid-19 era, in terms of health, hygiene, safety and security for both tourists and employees alike.





# Implementation of the UNWTO COVID-19 Tourism Recovery Technical Assistance Package (i)

Within the framework of the UNWTO COVID-19 Tourism Recovery Technical Assistance Package, UNWTO is implementing COVID-19 tourism recovery projects in collaboration with various development partners, as follows:

- European Bank for Development and Reconstruction (EBRD), with a budget of more than two million euros for thirteen countries: Tailor made projects implemented or about to be launched in Croatia, Greece, Georgia, Egypt, Jordan, Montenegro, Morocco, Tunisia, Turkey, Uzbekistan. Projects to be launched at a second stage in: Albania, Armenia, Lebanon
- Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA), with a budget of over half a million euros: Comprehensive tourism recovery projects in the Maldives and the Dominican Republic.



# Implementation of the UNWTO COVID-19 Tourism Recovery Technical Assistance Package (ii)

- Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) and the Organization of American States (OAS): Support provided to the development of harmonized Biosafety Protocols in the Tourism Sector for Latin America and Carribean Countries.
- Asian Development Bank (ADB): Technical assistance offered to implementing COVID-safety protocols and establishing a travel bubble between Almaty (*Kazakhstan*) and Bishkek (*Kyrgyz Republic*).
- United Nations Development Programme (UNDP): Socio-economic impact assessment carried out of COVID-19's impact on Zambia's tourism sector.
- In total, in the past year, UNWTO has already launched 15 COVID-19 tourism recovery projects with the resources mobilized through the EBRD, JICA, UNDP and ADB. Dialogue on collaboration in COVID-19 tourism recovery is on-going with other donors and development partners.
