# Terms and Conditions of the UNWTO Depository Libraries Programme

(updated January 2022, entering into force on 1 March 2022)

As the leading international organization in the field of tourism, the World Tourism Organization undertakes large projects of research, analysis and data gathering within a variety of different segments and regions. The results are regularly released in numerous publications and provide a valuable and reliable source of information. Through its advantageous Depository Library Programme, UNWTO promotes access by a wider audience to all the information and knowledge it acquires.

The participating libraries will receive all the official UNWTO publications in at least one of the official languages of the Organization (Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Spanish and Russian).

#### **Requirements for Depository Libraries**

Interested libraries must fulfil the following selection criteria and rules:

- 1. The interested library must belong to an institution of higher academic education or an acknowledged institution in the field of science.
- 2. All designated depository libraries are expected to place the material received in the care of qualified library staff and to keep it under bibliographic control.
- All designated libraries are obliged to make UNWTO publications accessible to their students, free of charge, at reasonable opening hours. UNWTO does not accept publications to be placed in personal reference libraries of teachers or similar (see paragraph 10 of the "Ordering rules").
- 4. Depository Libraries are also encouraged to make deposited items available through interlibrary loan to users within their area who cannot easily visit the depository library concerned.

#### **Ordering rules**

Once the requesting library is accepted as a UNWTO Depository Library,

- Libraries may request the delivery of one (1) copy of the works, in one or more of the
  official UNWTO languages at any time of the year. In the case of books published in
  another language, the library will receive the publication in its original language, which
  may differ from its preference.
- Participation in the Depository Libraries Programme must be maintained for at least 12 months. After that period, participation in the Programme may be cancelled at any time.

- 3. Publication shipments will be made regularly during the year according to the chosen languages, without the need for individual orders by the Depository Library.
- 4. Based on the request, the UNWTO offers the Depositary Library a 50% discount on the retail price of the publications.
- 5. The library will receive via e-mail an invoice detailing publications and shipping costs. This invoice must be paid within 90 days from the date of issuance.
- 6. UNWTO will proceed with the corresponding shipment as soon as the payment is successfully received.
- 7. To complete its UNWTO collection, the library has the right (under the same conditions described above) to make up to two batch orders of books published before the date
- 8. All depository libraries receive an accreditation plaque indicating their participation in the UNWTO Depositary Libraries Programme. In the event that the library withdraws from the Programme, the plaque must be removed.
- 9. All designated Depository Libraries accept to be recorded in the UNWTO Directory of Depository Libraries and also on the UNWTO Homepage.
- 10. The UNWTO reserves the right to confirm the observance of the conditions of UNWTO Depository Libraries through questionnaires or visits at any time.

Interested libraries located in countries currently designated by the United Nations as "least developed countries" (LDCs), which fulfil all mentioned selection criteria, are encouraged to apply for special discount conditions by sending an e-mail to: depositorylibrary@unwto.org.

The number of UNWTO publications varies each year. The total number and value of UNWTO publications of recent years provides an indication of the future benefits of participating in the UNWTO Depository Library Programme.
