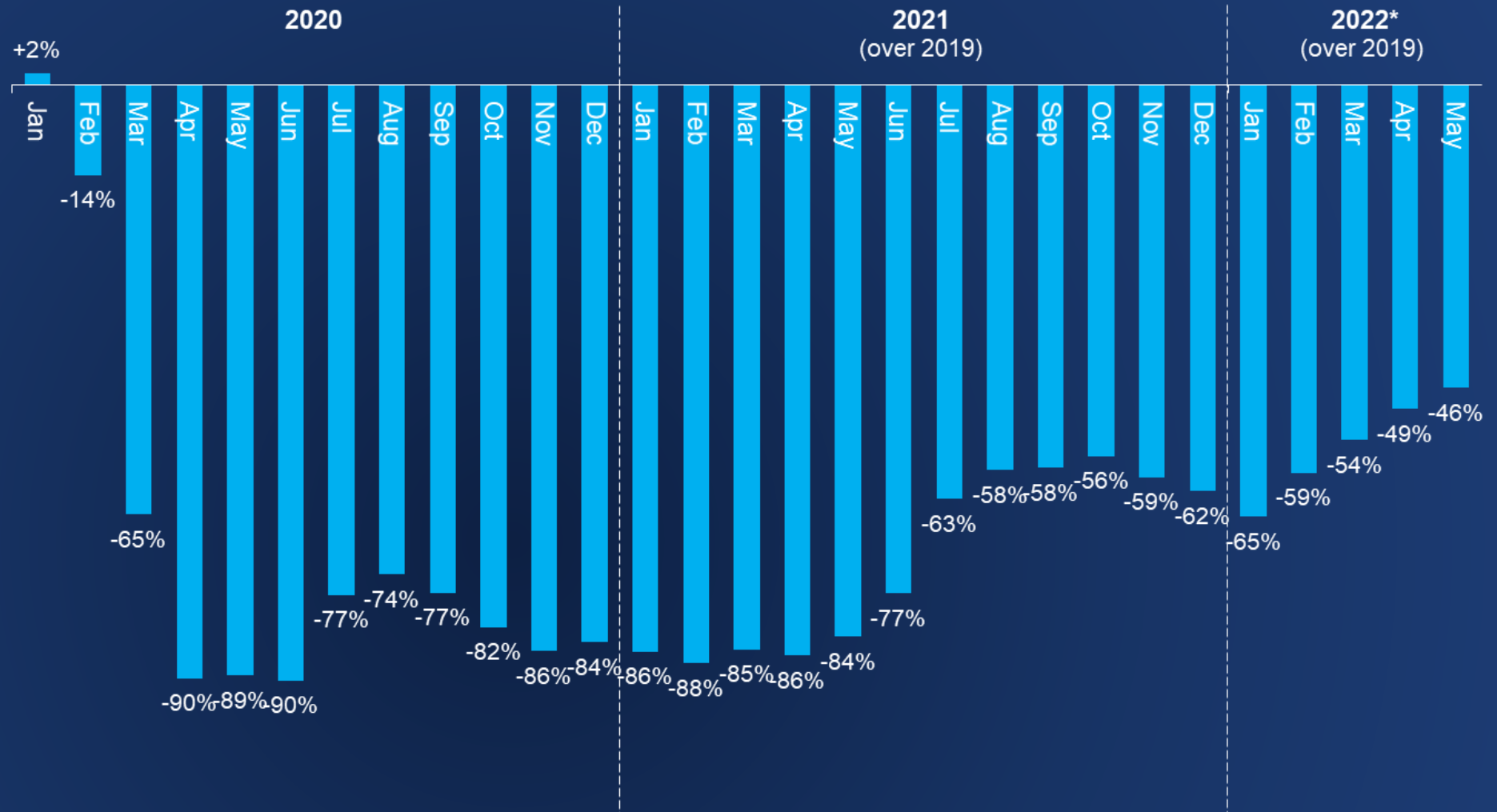

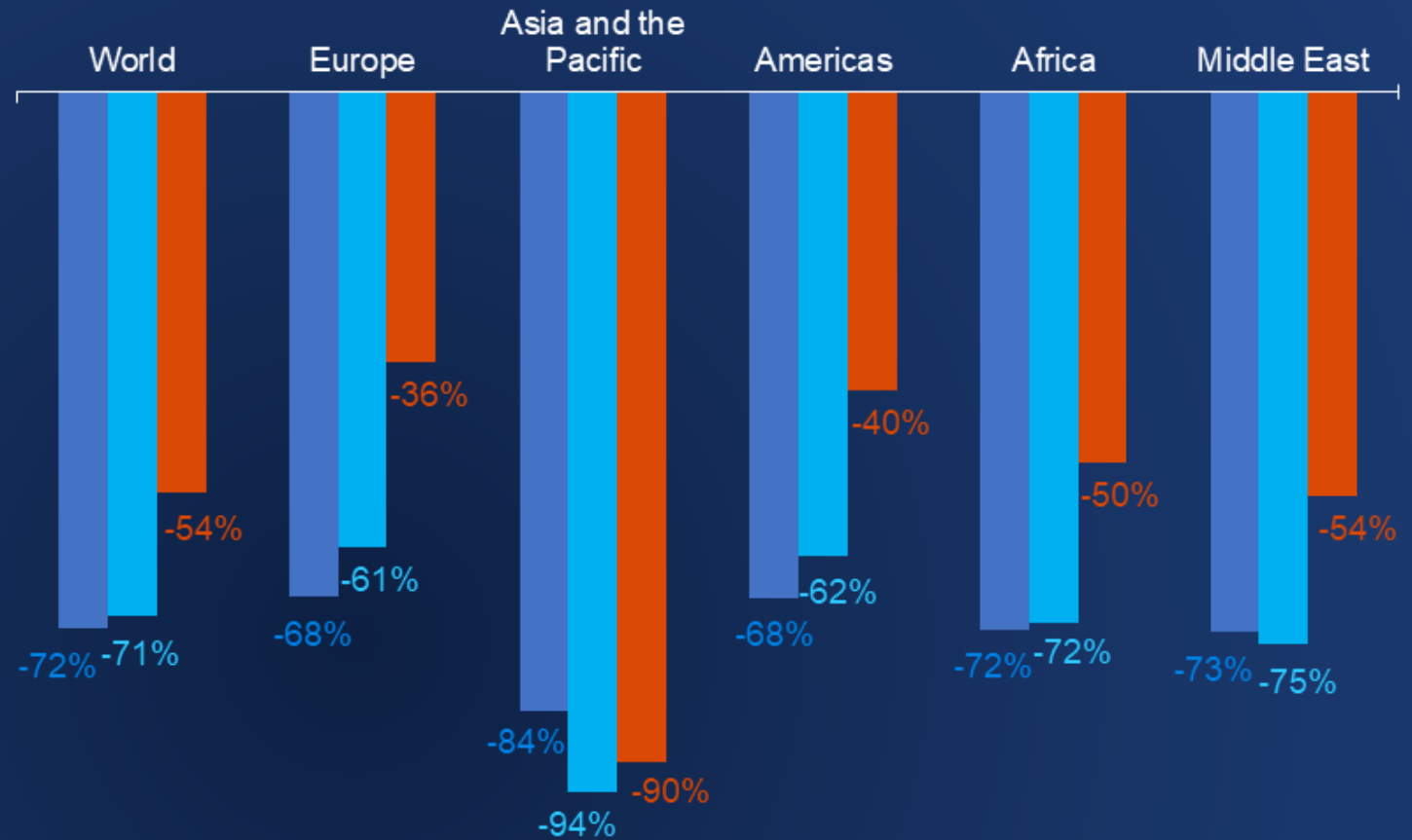

(% change vs. 2019)



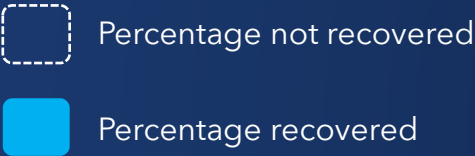

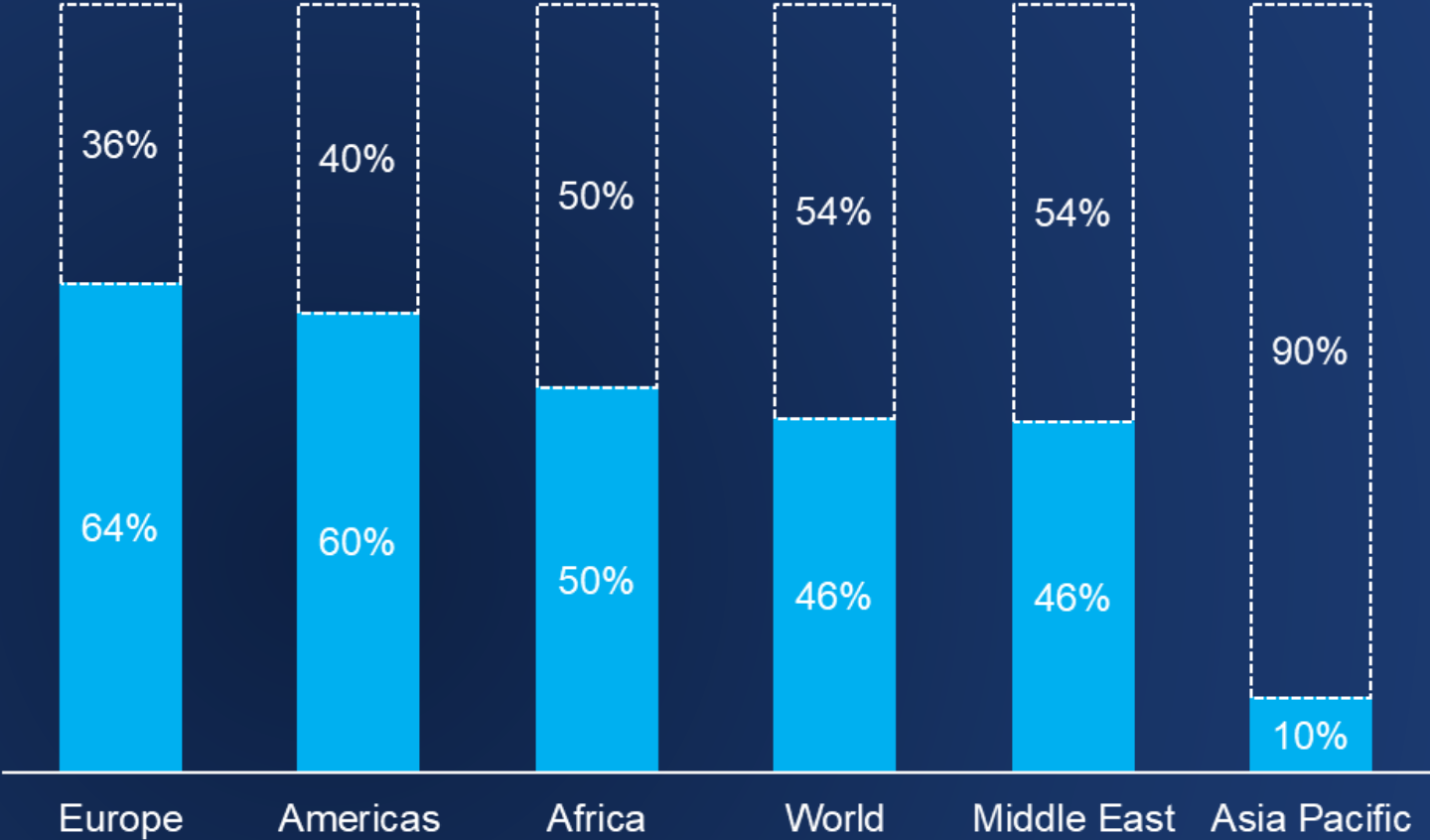


International tourist arrivals:

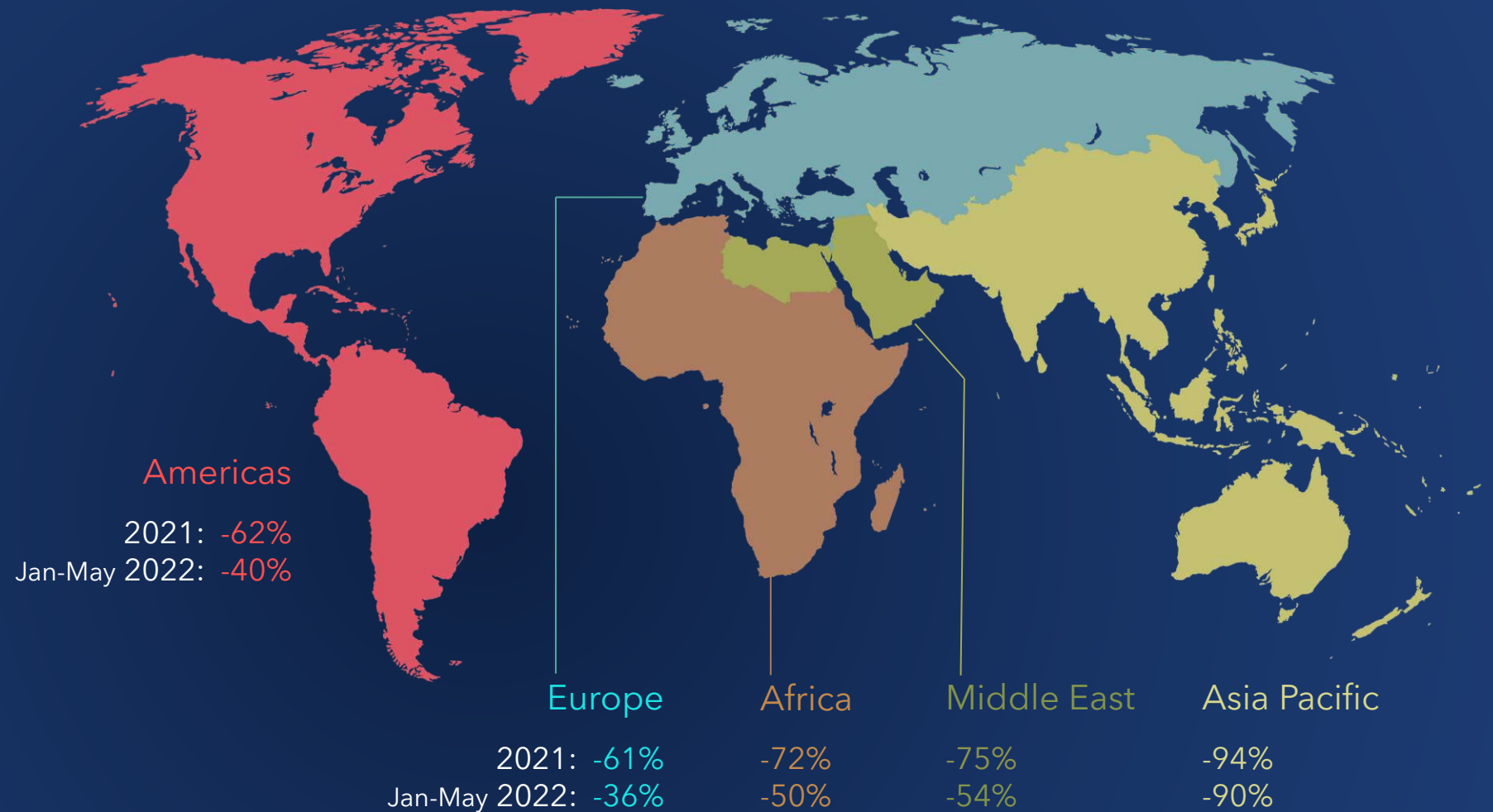

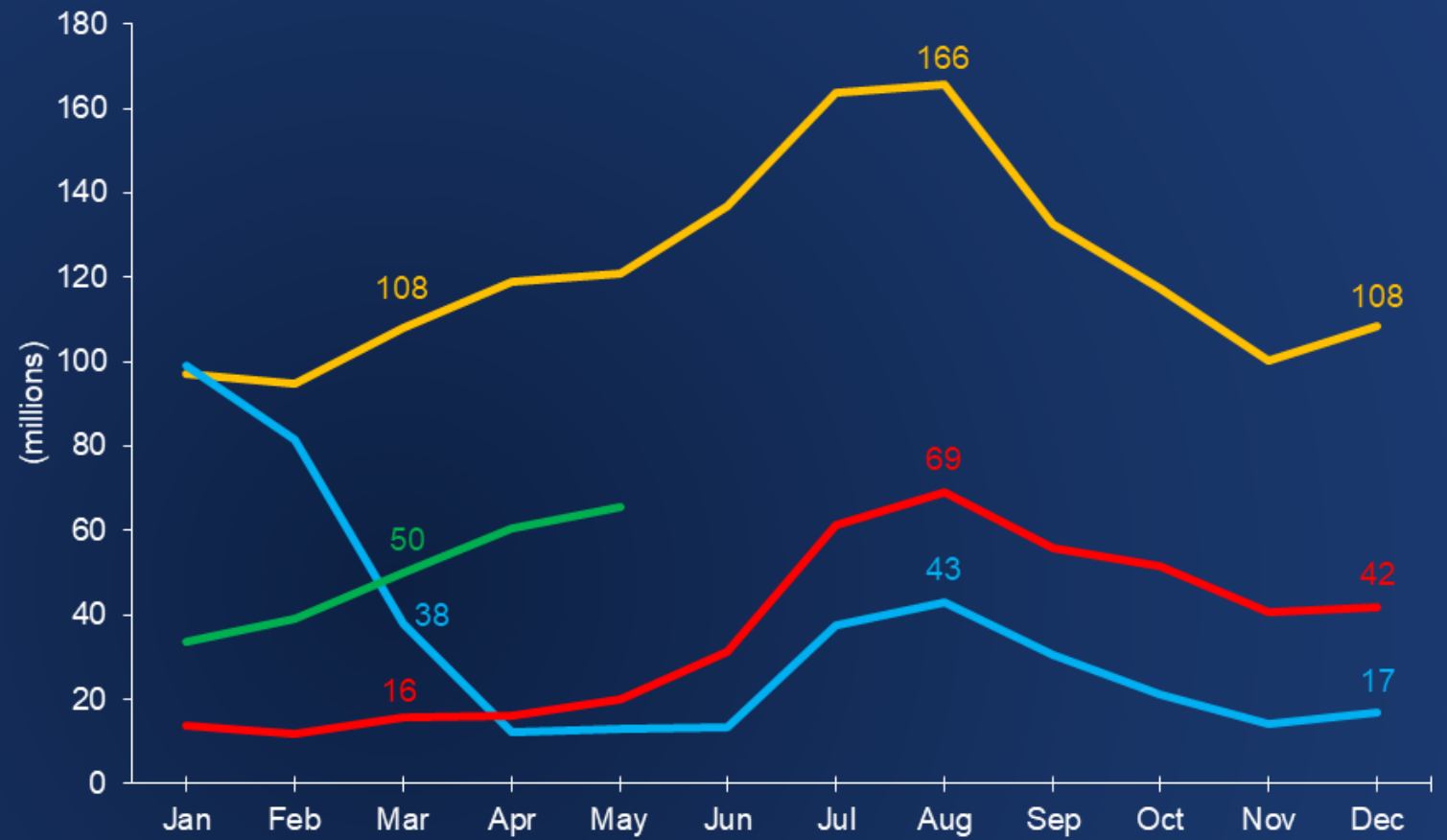

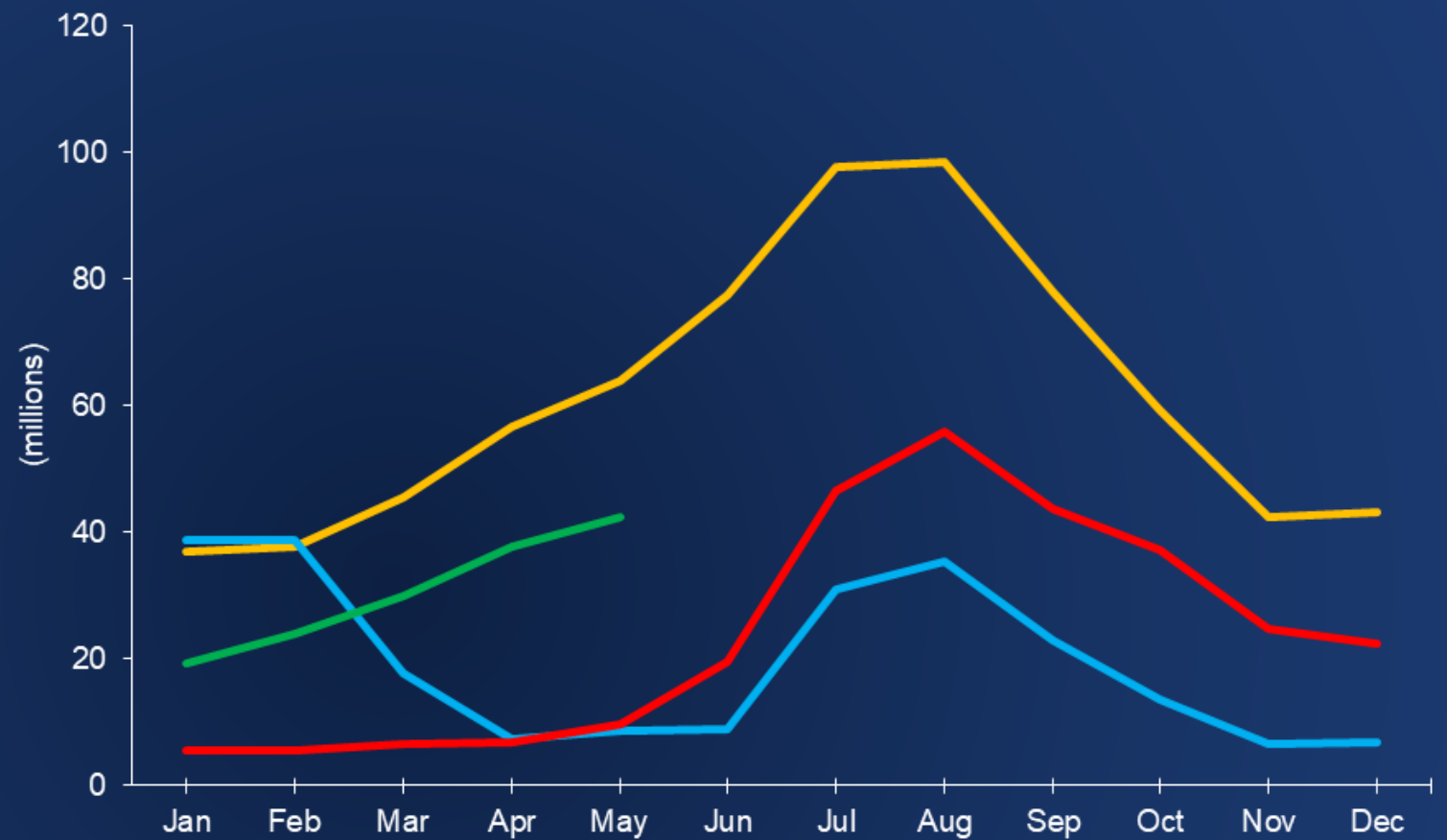

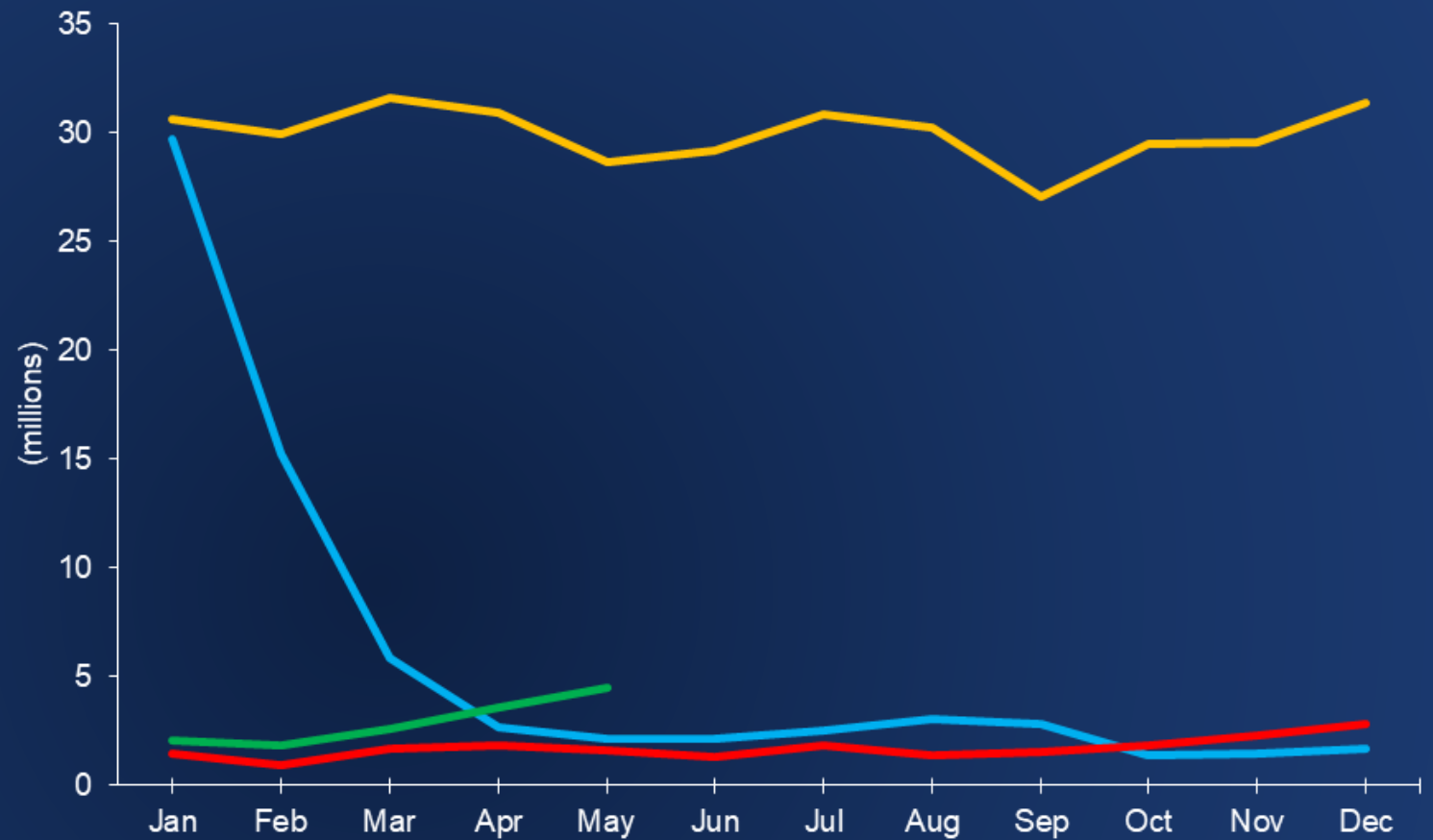

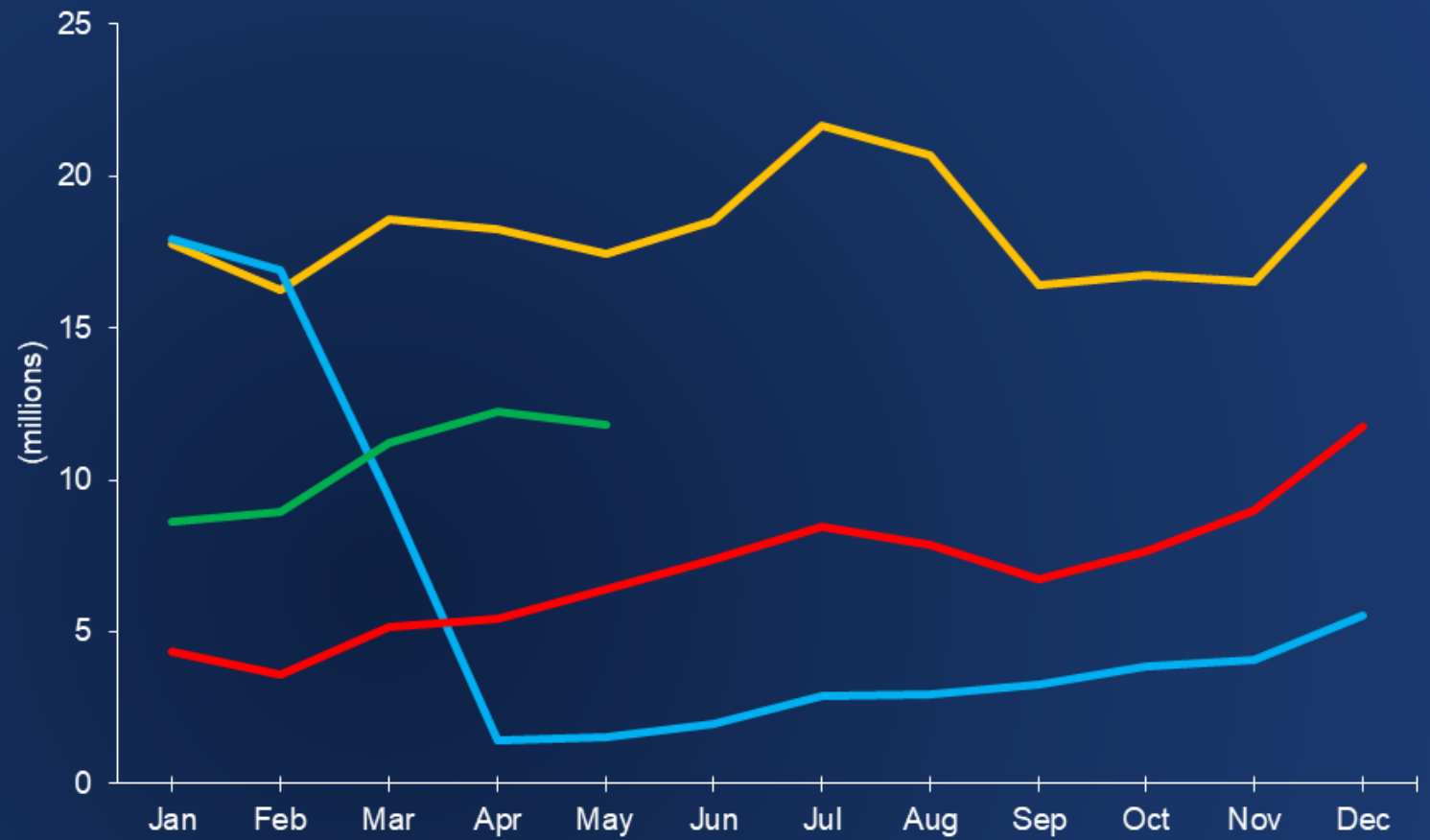

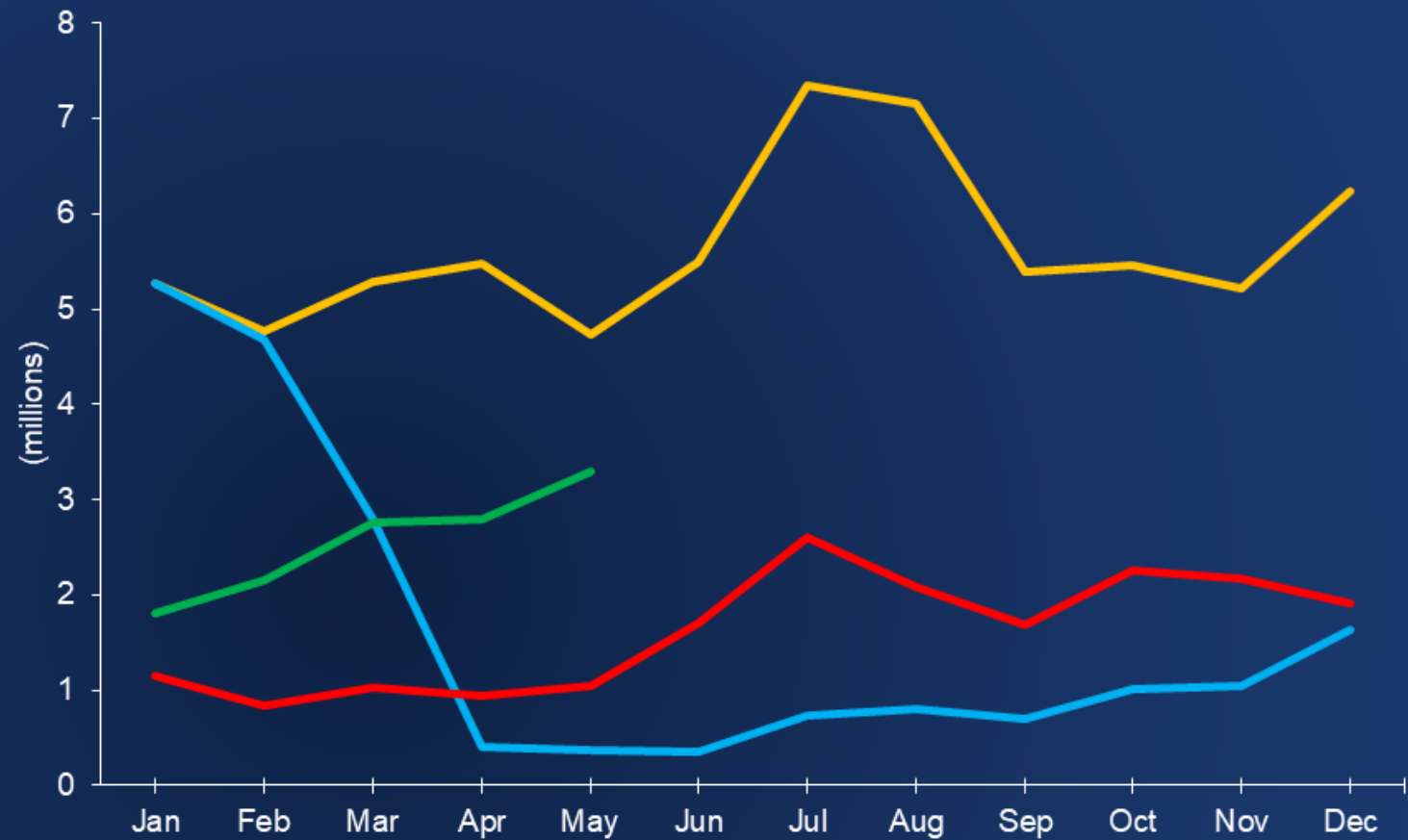

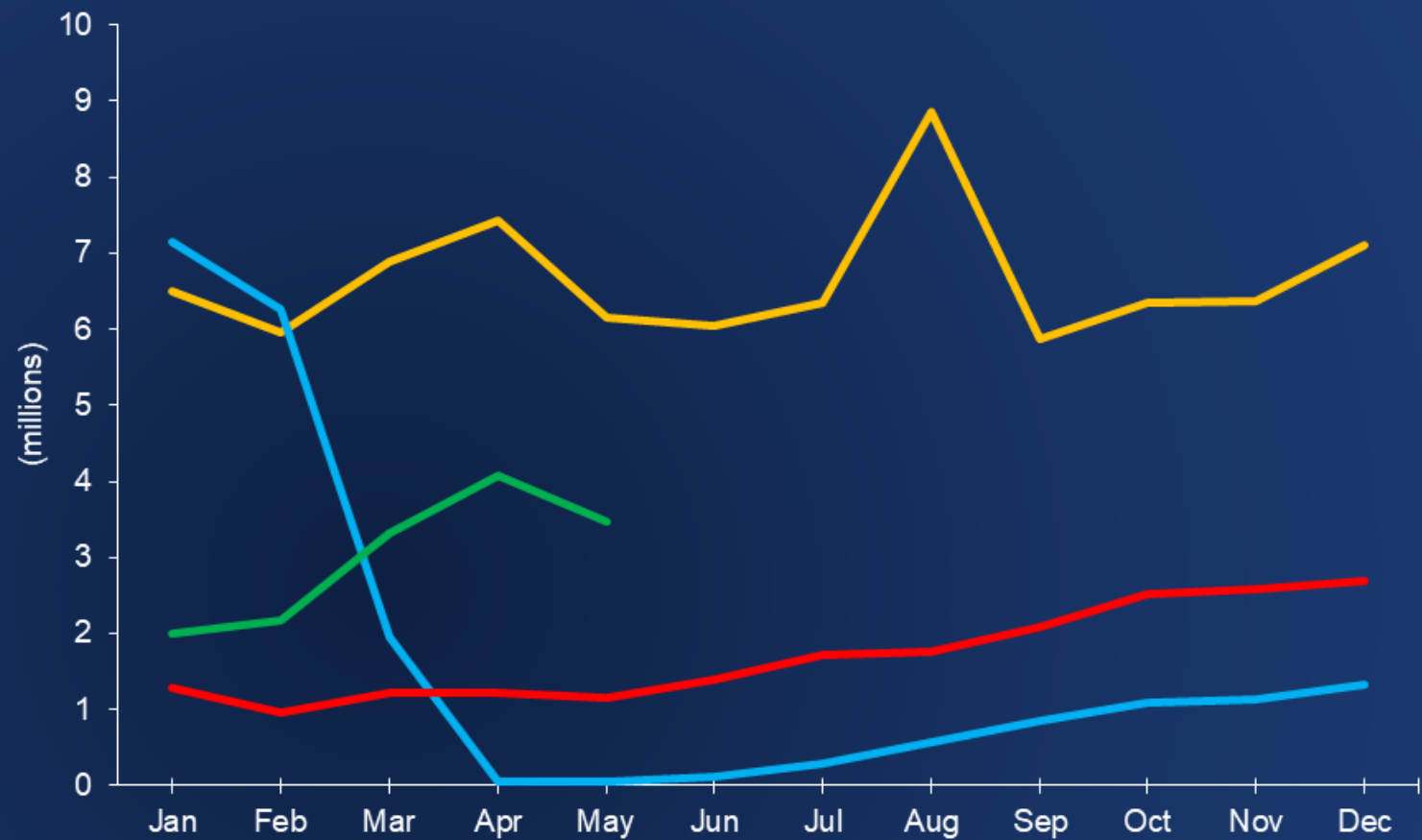

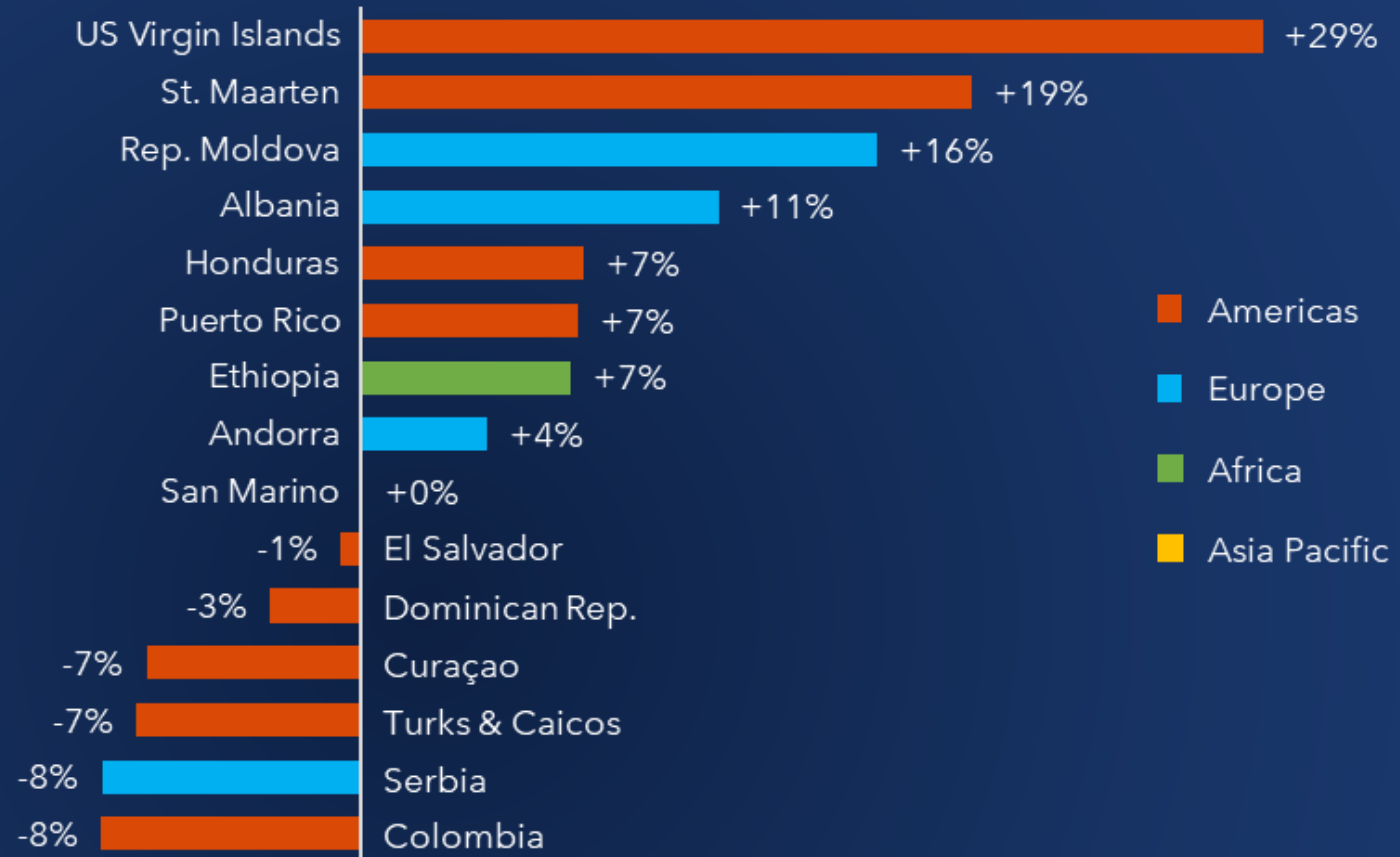

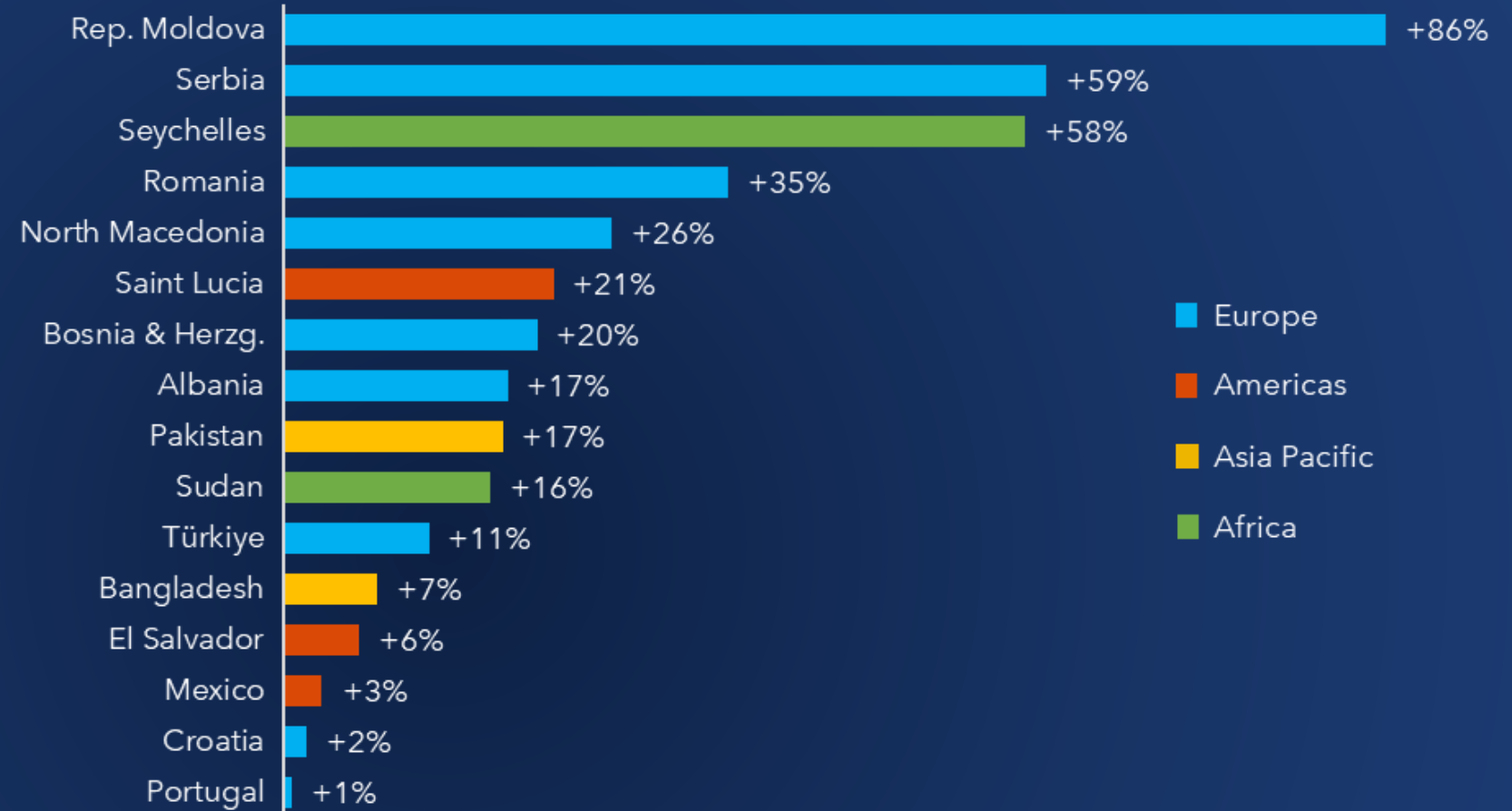


## Best performing destinations in terms of earnings: January-May 2022

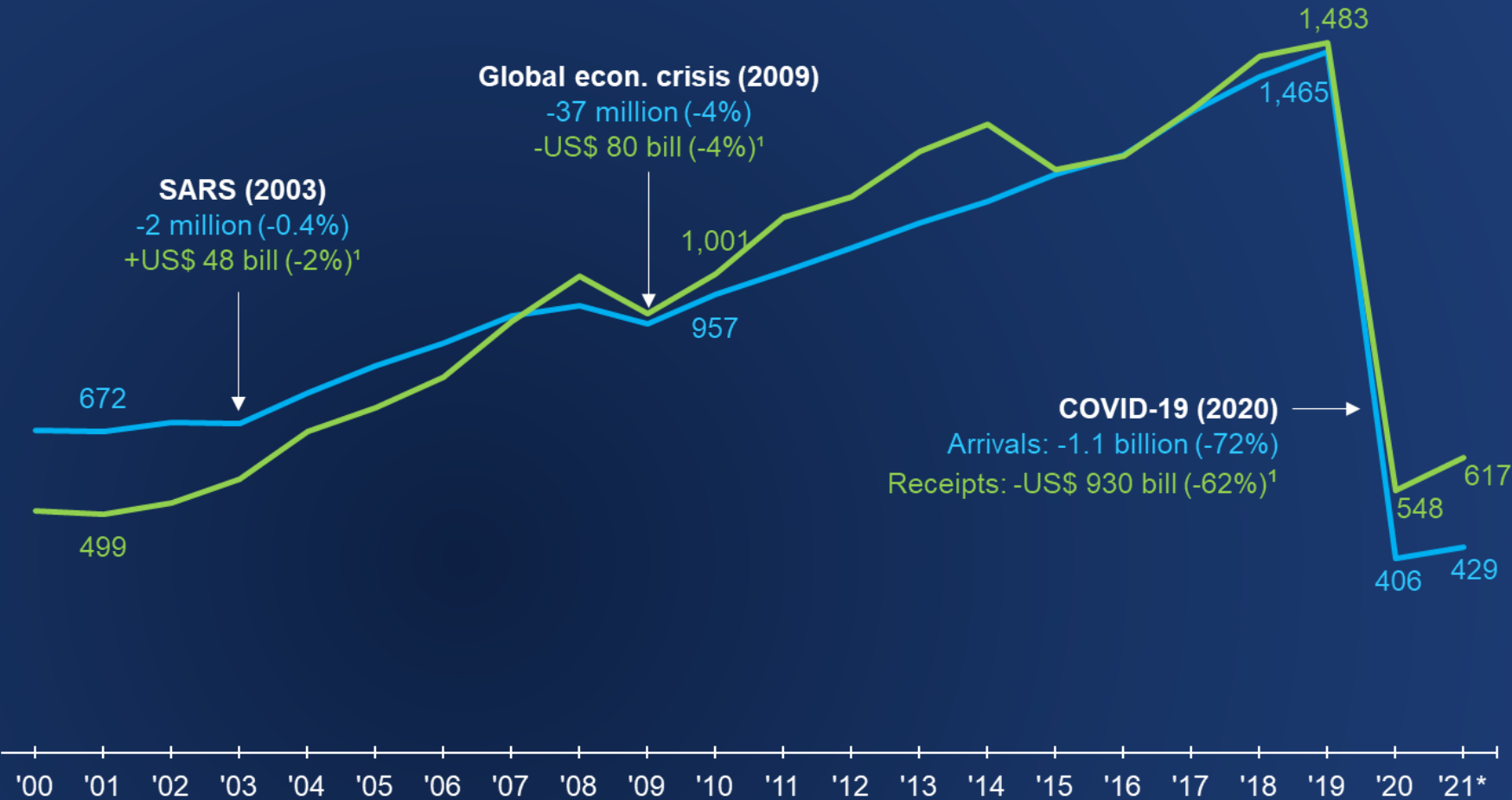

(millions, USD billions)

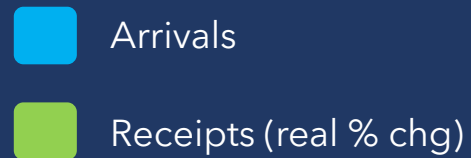

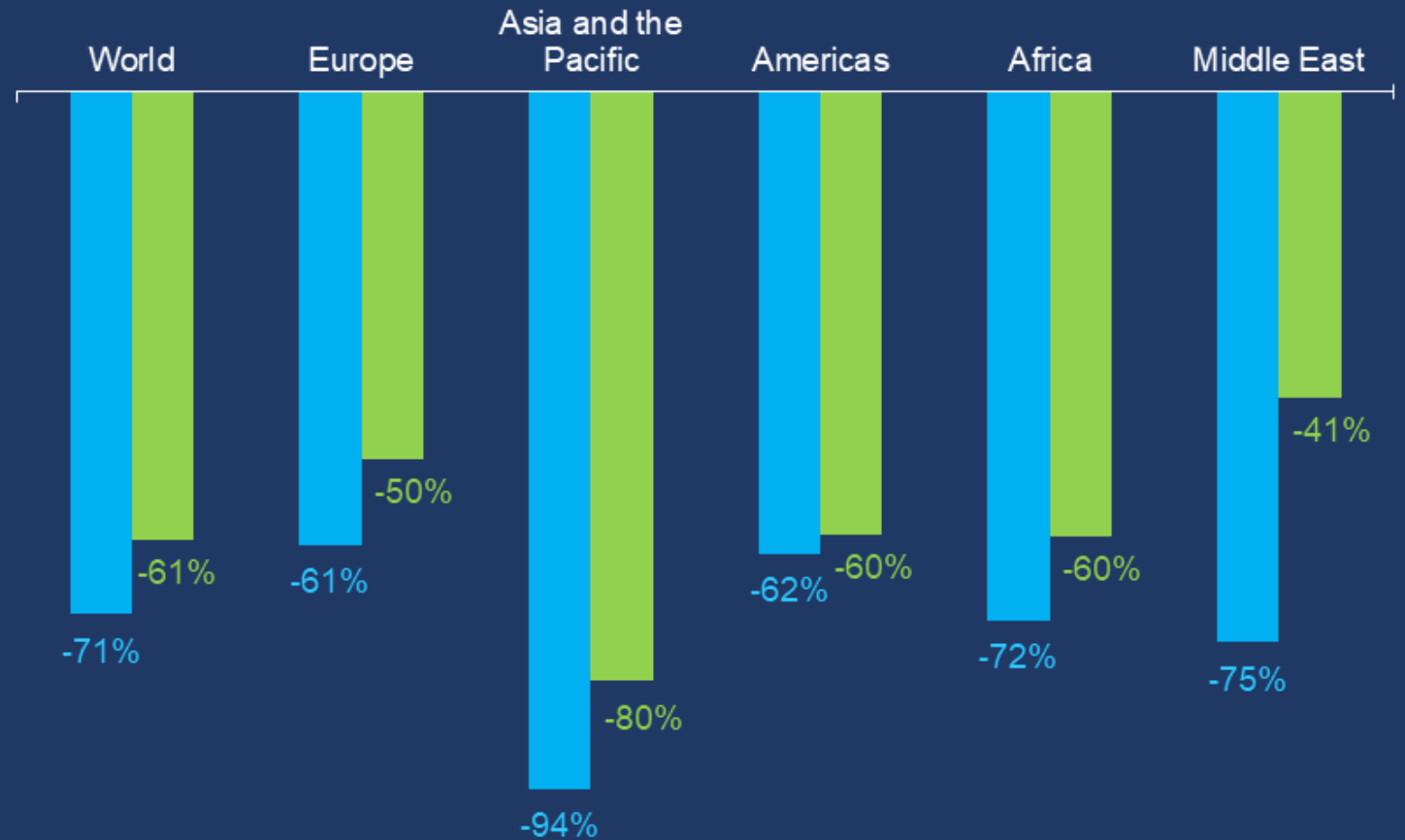

(% change vs. 2019)



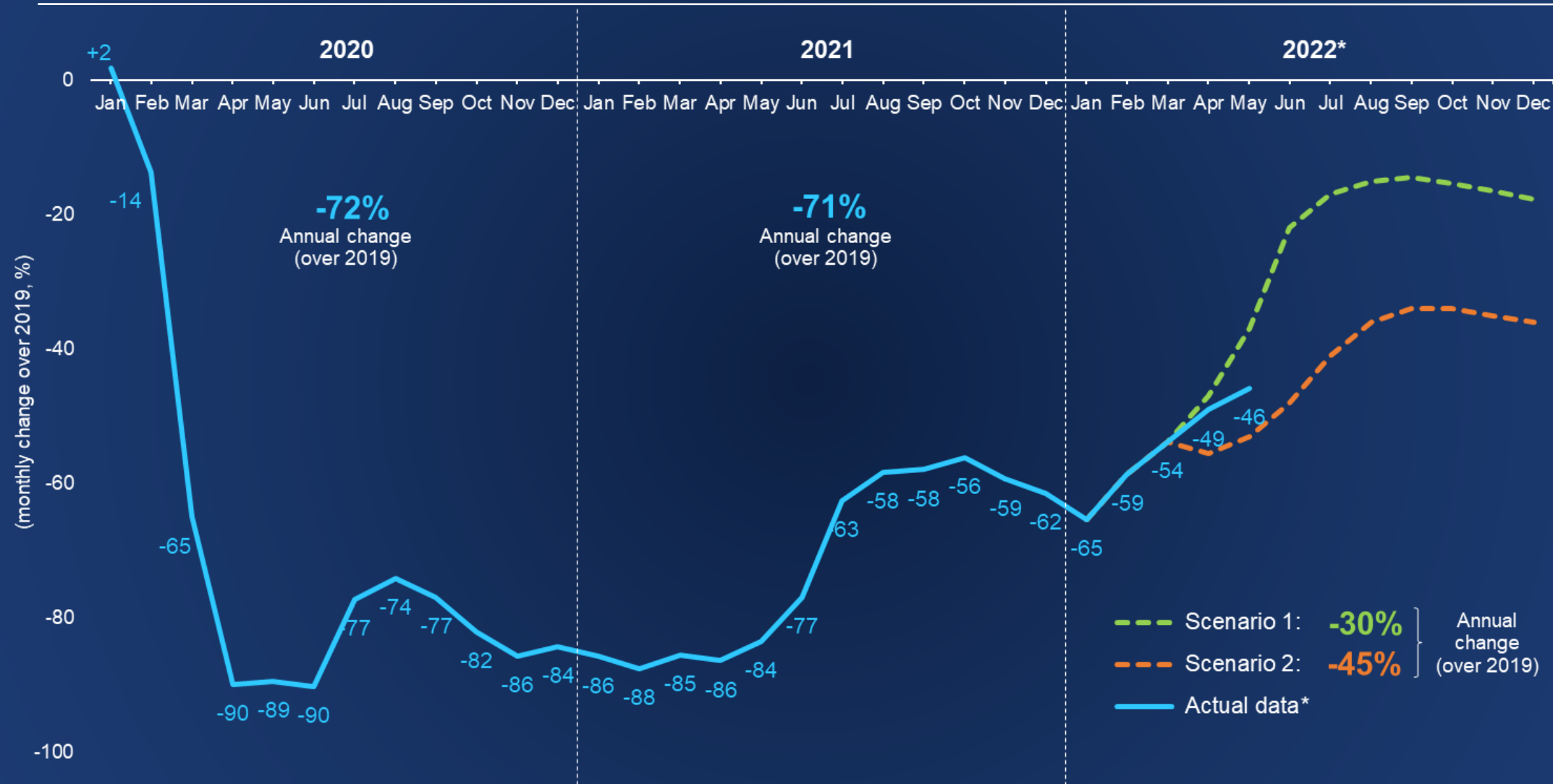

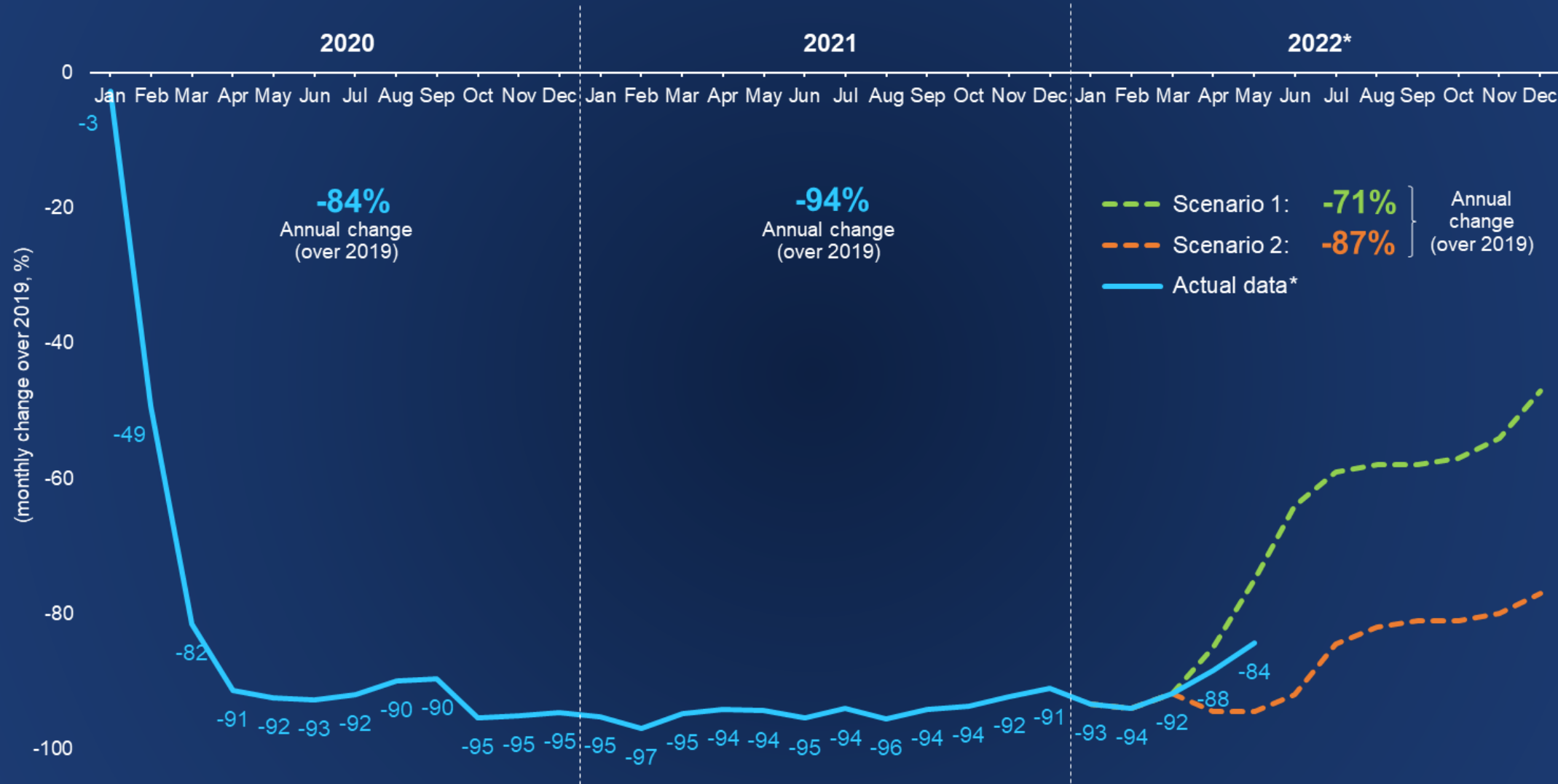

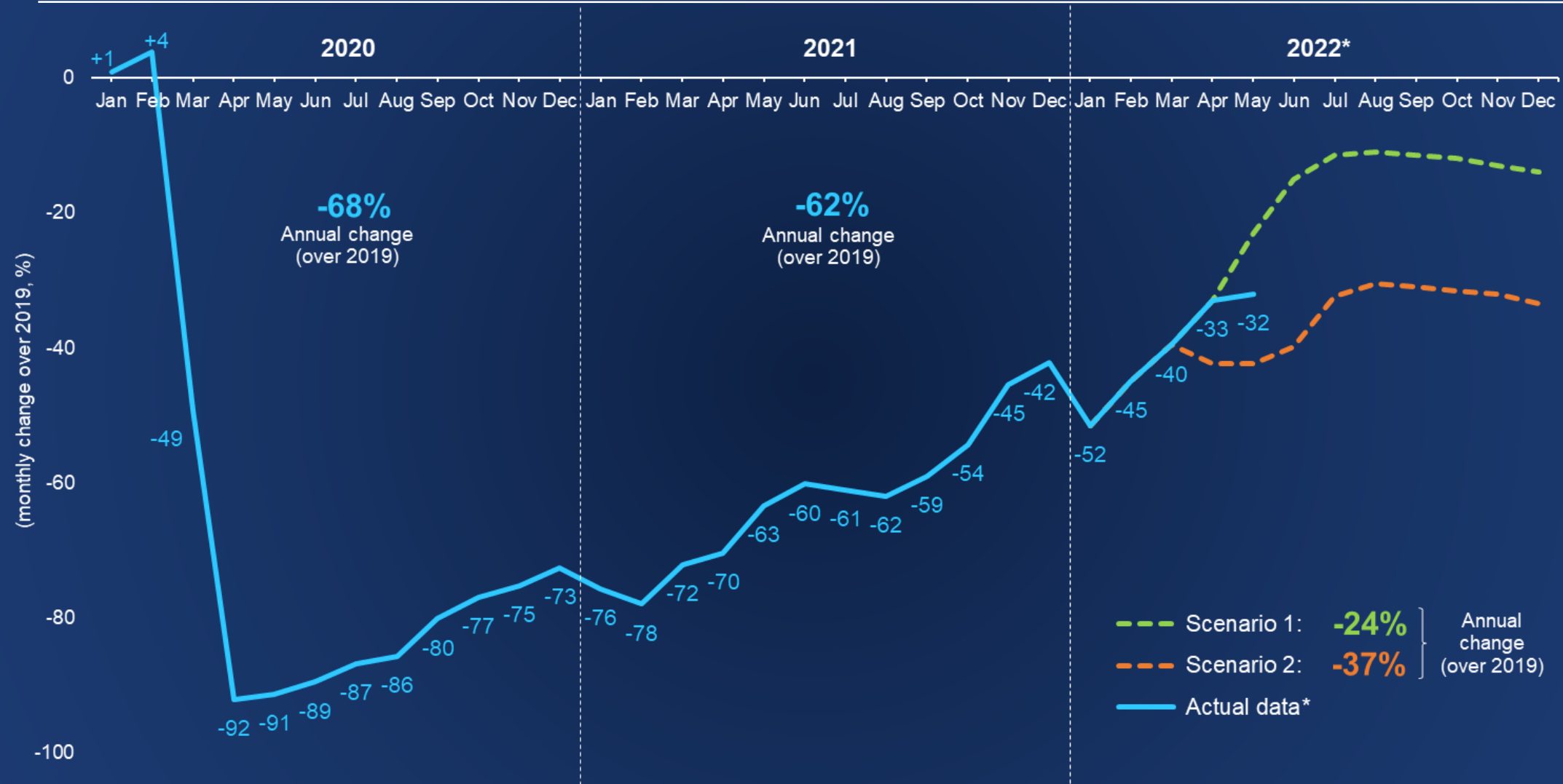

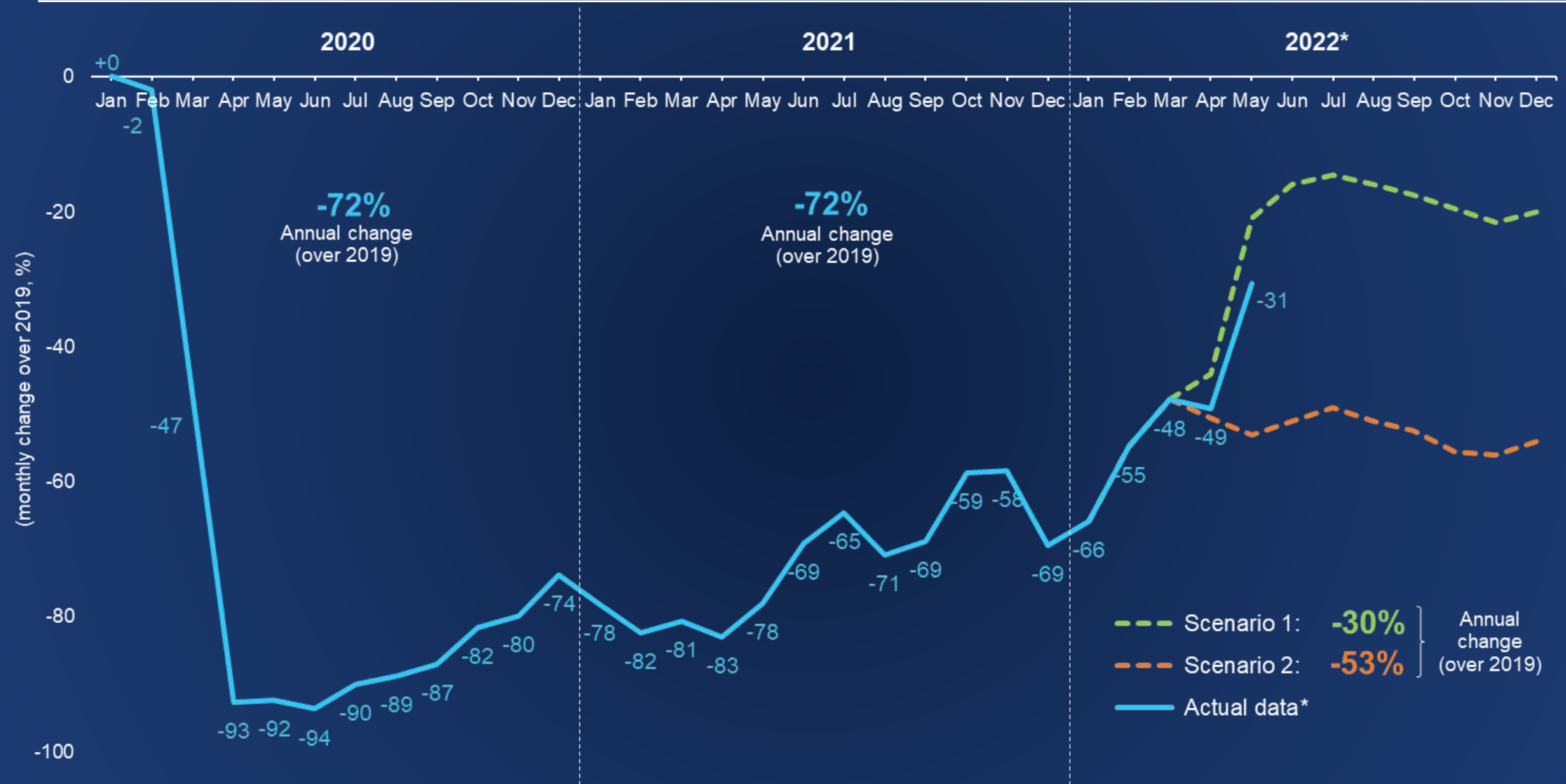
