The Secretariat of the World Tourism Organization presents its compliments to the Member States of the UNWTO (United Nations World Tourism Organization) Regional Commission for Africa and has the honor to inform them that the **Republic of Tunisia, People's Democratic Republic of Algeria and Republic of Mauritius** have presented their letter of intent to host the 66<sup>th</sup> meeting of the UNWTO Regional Commission for Africa to be held in 2023

Their candidature was notified through note Verbal addressed to the Secretary-General and of which a copy of each is available upon request. Chronologically they presented as follows:

The Republic of Tunisia 05 August 2022 The People's Democratic Republic of Algeria, 21 September 2022 The Republic of Mauritius, 26 September 2022

In the framework of the 65<sup>th</sup> UNWTO Regional Commission Meeting for Africa which will take place in Arusha, United Republic of Tanzania, from 5 to 7 October 2022, the Member States of the UNWTO Regional Commission for Africa shall take a decision on the hosting of the 66<sup>th</sup> UNWTO CAF Meeting based on the **provisional agenda item number 6** on the subject. The 65th UNWTO Regional Commission will be followed by forum on the theme "Rebuilding Africa's Tourism Resilience for Inclusive Socio-Economic Development",
