Agenda item 14 Election of the Executive Council Members A/23/14 Madrid, 14 August 2019 Original: English

Executive summary

The 23rd session of the UNWTO General Assembly will elect 17 Member States in the Executive Council for the period 2019-2023.

Nominations and elections to statutory organs and their subsidiary bodies, including nomination of candidates to represent the Regions on the Executive Council for the period 2019-2023, were held during the Regional Commission meetings for the Americas, Asia and the Pacific, Europe and the Middle East held in the first Semester of 2019.

The UNWTO Commission for Africa will make its nominations at its 62nd meeting to be held on the margins of the General Assembly.

Action by the General Assembly

DRAFT RESOLUTION¹

The General Assembly,

Having received the proposals of the Regional Commissions, the Associate Members and the Board of Affiliate Members,

1. *Declares* the following Full Members elected as members of the Executive Council for the period 2019-2023, for the 17 seats to be filled:

- 2. *Recalls* that the Associate Members will be represented by Flanders on the Executive Council until the 24th session of the General Assembly; and
- 3. *Takes note* that the Affiliate Members will be represented on the Executive Council by the Chair of the Board.

I. Executive Council: Election of Members

1. The General Assembly is required to elect, at each of its sessions, one-half of the membership of the Executive Council, in accordance with Article 14(1) of the Statutes of the Organization, which reads as follows²:

"The Council shall consist of Full Members elected by the Assembly in the ratio of one Member for every five Full Members, in accordance with the Rules of Procedure laid down by the Assembly, with a view to achieving fair and equitable geographical distribution."

2. Article 15 of the Statutes also stipulates that:

"The term of elected Members shall be four years. Election for one-half of the membership of the Council shall be held every two years."

3. This provision is enlarged upon in rule 55(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly, paragraph 4 of which reads:

"The term of office of the Members of the Council shall begin immediately following their election by the Assembly and shall end on the election of their successors."

- 4. Article 14(1) of the Statutes provides that the total number of the Organization's Full Members determines the number of seats on the Council. In order to achieve, so far as possible, fair and equitable geographical representation, the number of seats per region is calculated on the basis of one seat for every five Members out of the total number of Members in each region.
- 5. At its 22nd session in Chengdu, China, the General Assembly decided (resolution 697 (XXII) to amend Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly as follows:

"The Assembly shall elect by secret ballot the Members of the Council in the proportion of one Member of the Council for every five Full Members of the Organization, having regard to fair and equitable geographical distribution. This proportion shall be applied to the number of Full Members by region (see annex I) in order to determine the number of seats on the Executive Council to be allocated to the corresponding region."

- 6. Consequently, in accordance with the number of Full Members per region at the date of this document, the Council may be composed of 34 members in addition to Spain as a permanent member, during the period between the twenty-third and twenty-fifth sessions of the General Assembly.
- 7. The current membership of the Executive Council whose terms of office expire in 2019 is indicated in Annex II.
- 8. The current membership of the Executive Council until 2021 and the nominated candidates (2019-2023) by the Regional Commissions to the Executive Council to be elected by the General Assembly are indicated in Annex III.
- 9. Seventeen Full Members will have to be elected to the Council in the ratio of 1 member for every 5 Full Members per region, as follows:

Americas	2 seats
East Asia and the Pacific	4 seats
Europe	4 seats
Middle East	1 seat
South Asia	0 seats
South Asia	0 seats

- 10. The 62nd Meeting of the UNWTO Commission for Africa was cancelled due to the unavoidable circumstances. It will take place on the margins of the upcoming UNWTO General Assembly.

- 12. It should be recalled that Executive Council decisions 4(XXXIII) and 4(XXXIV) recommend that "...only Members of the Organization having no unjustified arrears (paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules attached to the Statutes) shall be eligible for election to the Executive Council".
- 13. At its 22nd session, the Assembly took note of the nomination of Flanders as representative of the Associate Members to the Executive Council until the 24th General Assembly session (A/RES/704(XXII)).
- 14. The Board of Affiliate Members is requested to nominate its representative to serve on the Executive Council. This function is traditionally shouldered by the Chair of the Board.
