IV. ENTRY FORMALITIES

6. All participants entering Malaysia must possess a valid Passport or internationally recognised Travel Document. The document shall be valid, for more than six (6) months from the date of entry into Malaysia.

<u>Note</u>:

- Foreign nationals who require a Visa to enter Malaysia must apply and obtain a Visa in advance at any Malaysian Representative Office abroad before entering the country.
- The countries marked (*) are allowed to enter Malaysia by air only.
- Israel citizens** who wish to enter Malaysia are required to apply for a Visa and approval from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Malaysia.
- Visa is not required for a stay of less than one (1) month for ASEAN nationals except Myanmar. Visas are required if duration of stay exceeds one (1) month except for Brunei and Singapore nationals.

V. CUSTOMS REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURE

- 7. Under Malaysian law, every person arriving in or leaving Malaysia must declare all dutiable or prohibited goods, cash and/or BNI exceeding USD10,000 equivalent in his possession either on his person, in any baggage or in any vehicle to a Customs officer. Failure to make a declaration is an offence.
- 8. A Customs officer may conduct examination of any person, baggage or vehicle. Further information on Malaysia's customs regulation, dutiable and prohibited items can be obtained from the nearest Malaysia Embassy/Consulate in your country or on the Royal Malaysian Customs <u>website</u>.

VI. <u>YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS</u>

9. A Yellow Fever vaccination certificate is required to be produced upon landing in Malaysia for countries listed below:

- 10. Delegates without a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate shall be quarantined upon arrival in Malaysia for a period not exceeding six (6) days.
- 11. The period of validity of an international certificate of vaccination against Yellow Fever is 10 years, beginning 10 days from the date of vaccination. If a person is revaccinated before the end of this period, the validity is extended for a further 10 years from the date of vaccination.
- 12. If the revaccination is recorded on a new certificate, delegates are advised to retain the old certificate for 10 days until the new certificate becomes valid.

VII. <u>COVID-19 MEASURES</u>

13. Since 1 May 2022, inbound travellers fully-vaccinated against COVID-19 are <u>no longer</u> <u>required</u> to undergo pre-departure and on-arrival tests, including children aged 12 and below as well as for those who have been infected with COVID-19 within six to 60 days before departure to Malaysia. Travel insurance is also <u>not a prerequisite</u> for travellers

entering the country, but is highly recommended in case of any medical emergencies.

- 14. Inbound travellers who are <u>not fully vaccinated</u> against COVID-19 will need to undergo an RT-PCR test two (2) days before departure as well as a professionallyadministered RTK-Ag test within 24 hours upon arrival in Malaysia and observe a five (5)-day quarantine (quarantine exemption is only for those aged 17 and below).
- 15. Since 1 August 2022, inbound travellers to Malaysia are **no longer required** to fill in the Traveller's Card on the country's contact tracing app, MySejahtera.
- 16. The Ministry of Health Malaysia continues to monitor travellers' health symptoms at all international points of entry into Malaysia. Upon arrival in Malaysia, if a traveller is detected to have fever through the thermal scanner or found to be unwell, they will be referred for re-examination by the health department.
- 17. After re-examination, if there is a suspected illness due to COVID-19, monkeypox or MERS-CoV, the traveller will be taken to a nearby health facility for further check-up and treatment.

VIII. TRANSPORT

- Scheduled free transportation will be provided for the convenience of delegates arriving at the Kota Kinabalu International Airport (BKI) from 26-27 November 2022 for transfer to WTC 2022 Partner Hotels as at para 22 of this General Information Note, and from the hotel to the airport for departure on 1 December 2022.
- 19. It will take approximately 30 minutes from the airport to reach the designated hotels which are located in the city centre. Scheduled free shuttle service will also be provided to ferry participants from the designated hotels to the conference venue and return.
- 20. The schedule for free shuttle will be updated in due course.

IX. <u>RECEPTION AT THE AIRPORT</u>

21. A reception and information desk will be open for delegates at the Kota Kinabalu International Airport from **26**th **November 2022** at the arrival hall, including VIP arrivals, to assist participants with immigration formalities, baggage collection, transport and transfers to hotels.

X. <u>ACCOMMODATION</u>

22. Delegates are requested to make their own arrangements by contacting their preferred hotel via the contact details provided, and to make their reservations directly with the hotels listed in <u>Annex 1</u>. Delegates should specify that they will be attending the World Tourism Conference (WTC) 2022 on 28-30 November 2022 as special room rates may apply.

XI. SOCIAL PROGRAMME

23. All delegates will be invited to attend the WTC 2022 Official Dinner (hosted by the

Sabah State Government) on 28 November 2022.

- 24. Complimentary Technical Tours on 30 November 2022 are available for all international delegates. Registered participants will be invited to select their preferred choice for Technical Tour at a later date. Places are limited for the technical tour and will be on a first come, first served basis.

INTRODUCING MALAYSIA

Country	:	MALAYSIA
		Malaysia is a country with fascinating people and an enthralling range of attractions. Its three major races, the Malays, Chinese and Indians, alongside the Kadazan, Dusun, Iban and many more ethnicities of East Malaysia, make up the delightful multicultural fabric of Malaysia.
		Asia's cultural melting pot is enriched further with the influence of the British, Portuguese, Dutch and Thai. The Federation of Malaysia comprises Peninsular Malaysia; made up of 11 states; three federal territories and the states of Sabah and Sarawak in Borneo.
Capital City	:	Kuala Lumpur
Area	:	329,758 sq km
Population Language	:	30,949,962 (July 2016 est.) Bahasa Malaysia is the national language but English is widely spoken.
Religion	:	Islam is the official religion but all other religions are practised freely.
Climate	:	Tropical climate with warm weather all year round. Temperatures range from 21°C to 34°C. Annual rainfall varies from 2,000 mm to 2,500 mm.
Time Zone	:	Eight hours ahead of GMT (GMT+8) and 16 hours ahead of US Pacific Standard Time.
Currency	:	Malaysian Ringgit (RM)
		Travellers' cheque and foreign currencies can be changed for Malaysian Ringgit at banks and hotels. However, there are also money changer kiosks available at major shopping complexes and at the airport. Most major hotels charge a nominal fee for currency conversion.
Tipping	:	Most hotels and restaurants impose a 6% government sales tax (GST) and 10% service tax on bills and tipping is not customary. However, should you want to show your appreciation for good service, a small tip will suffice.

Shopping	:	All purchases are done in Malaysian Ringgit (RM). Major credit cards are accepted in most dining and retail outlets. Hypermarkets, supermarkets and most retail outlets have fixed prices for their goods, which are displayed on the products. However, bargaining is acceptable at selected retail outlets and is most common at night markets (<i>pasar malam</i>), or at bazaars. Shopping centres operate from 10.00 am to 10.00 pm with extended hours during sales and festive seasons.
Dining	:	Most eateries operate until late night. Selected eateries are also open 24 hours.
Insurance	:	Visitors are advised to obtain adequate insurance coverage before travelling to Malaysia.
Business Hour	:	In Malaysia, government offices are usually open for business during weekdays from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and closed on weekends and public holidays. Banks open from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Most shops and shopping malls are open from 10:00 am to 10:00pm.
Getting There	:	The state-of-the-art Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), KLIA2 and Subang Airport Selangor are the main gateways into the country.
