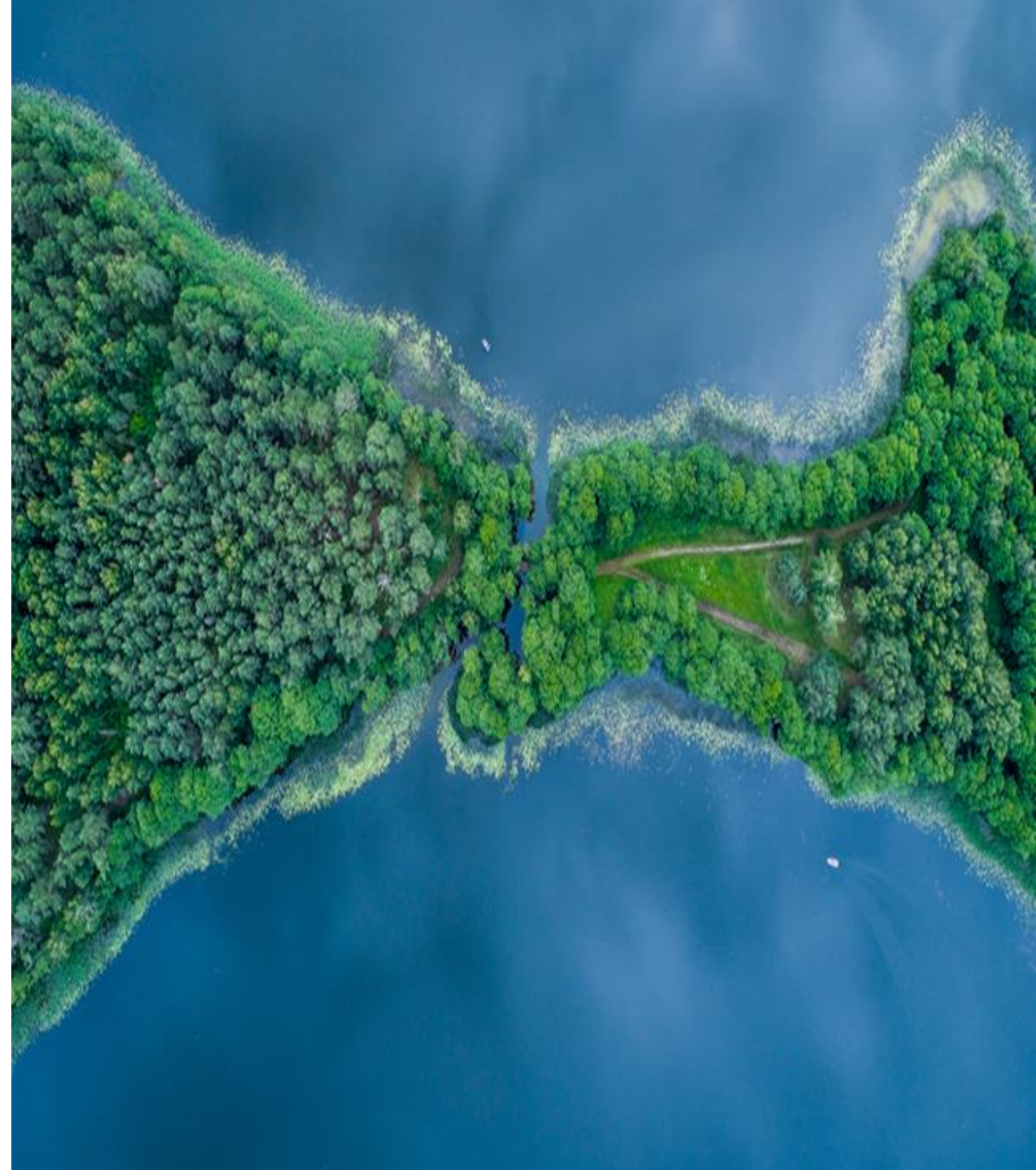
Lithuania

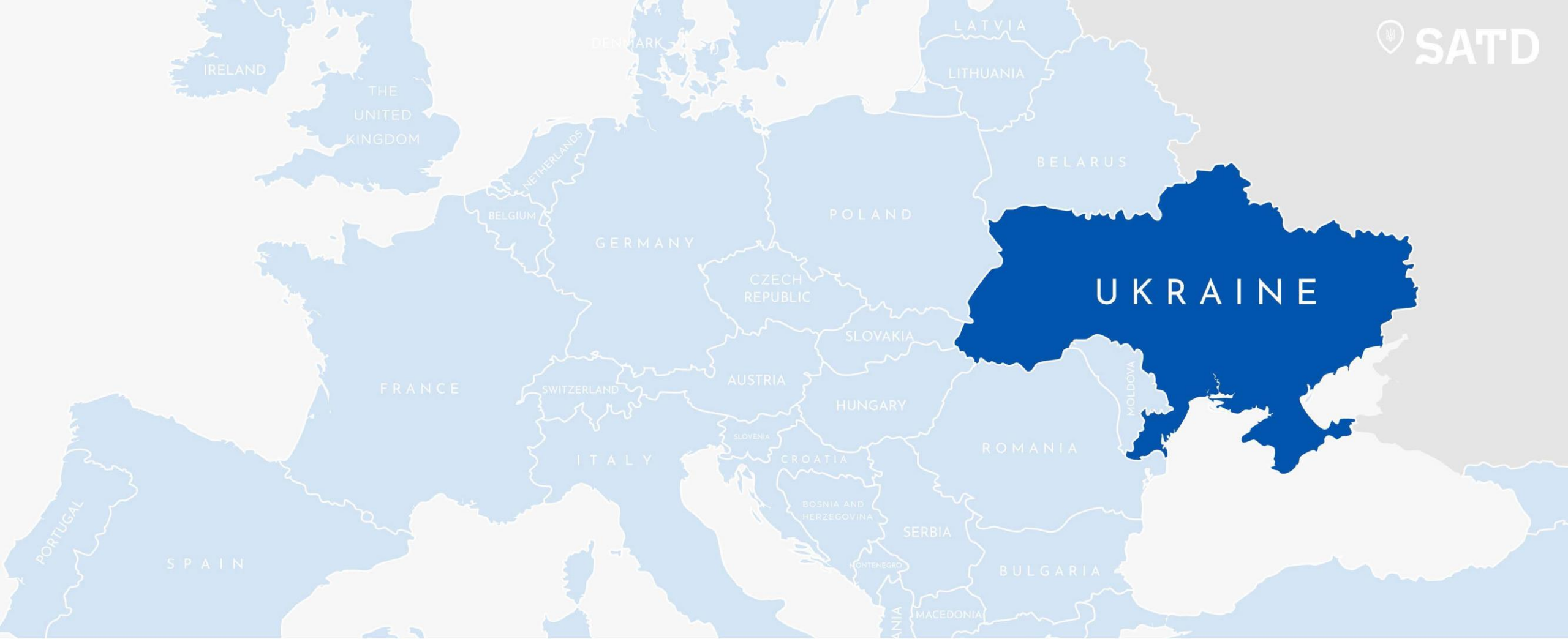

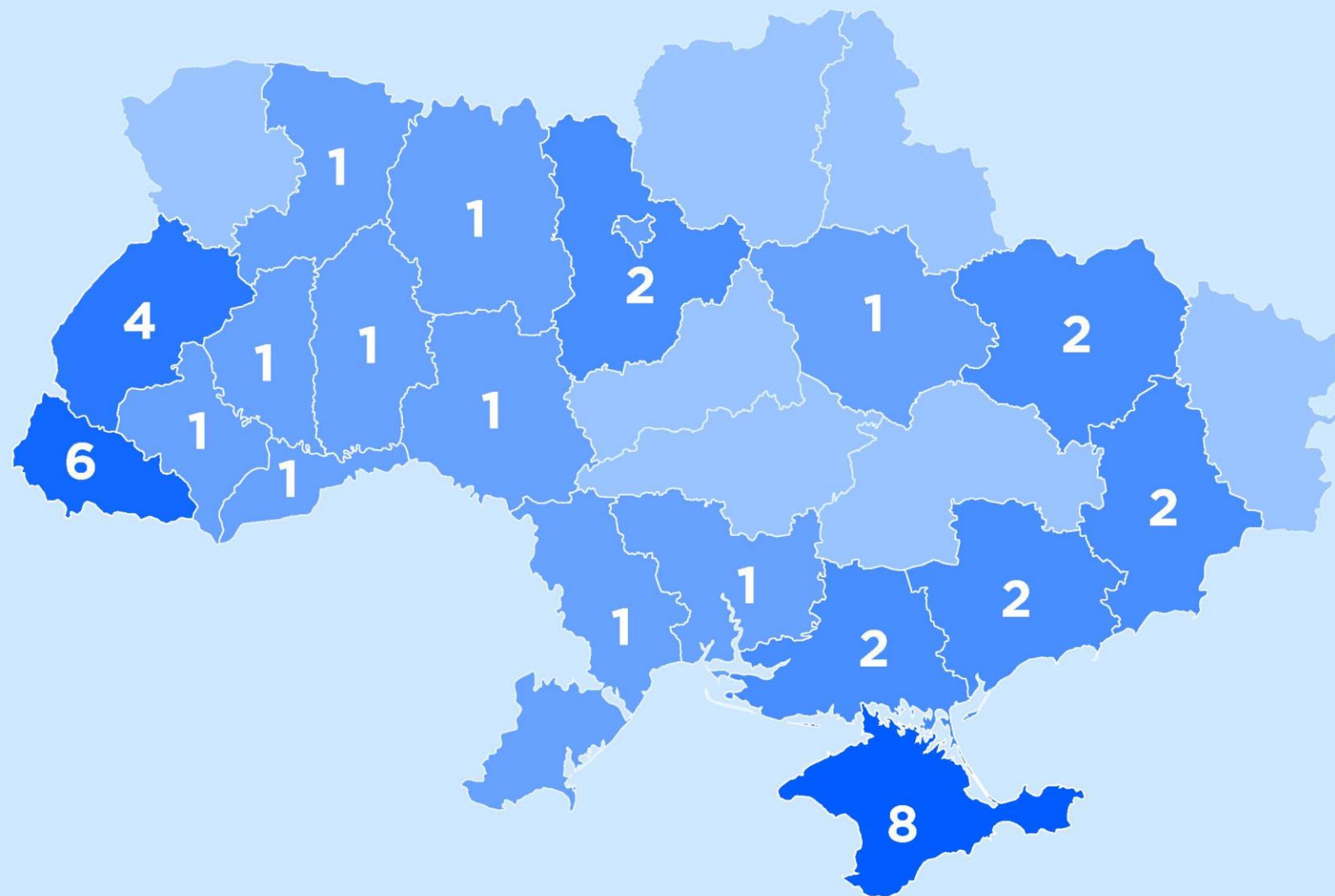

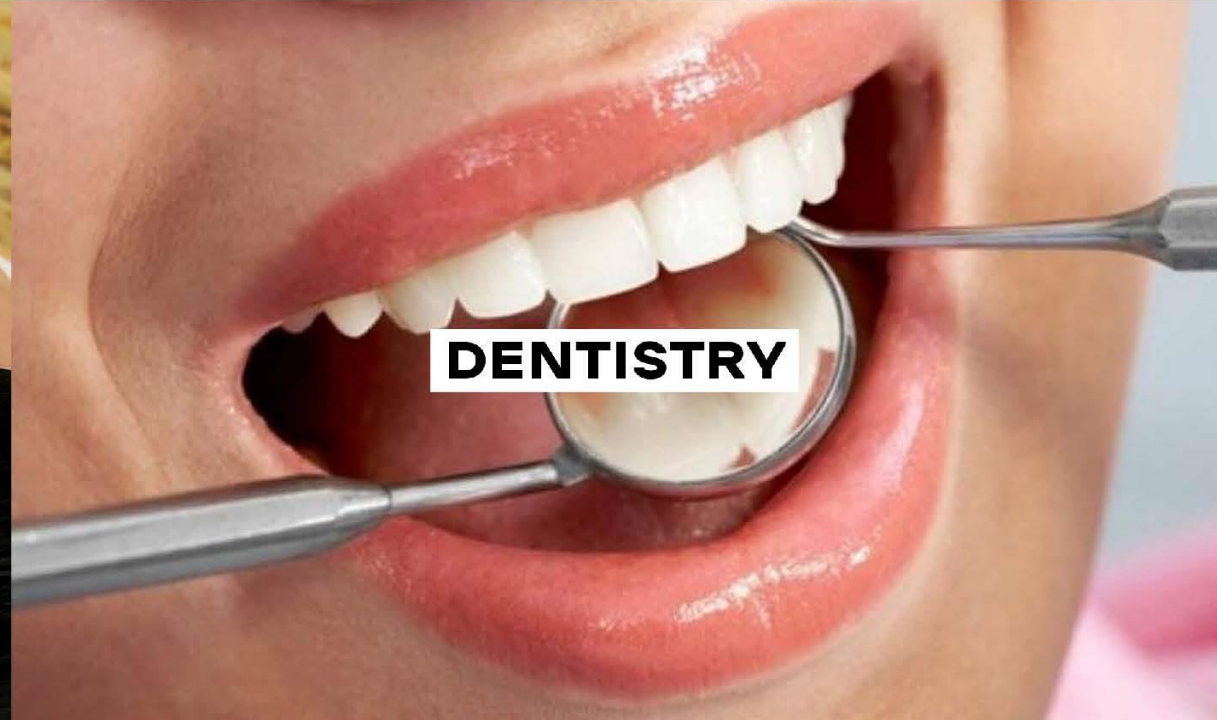
