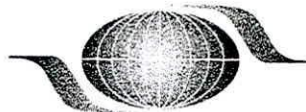

Addendum 2

1. On 23 November the Argentinian authorities sent to the Secretariat a communication relative to the text containing the draft amendments to Articles 6 and 7 of the Statutes adopted by the Executive Council at its seventy-fourth session (Salvador de Bahia, December 2004).

2. The Argentinian Ministry of Foreign Relations, International Trade, and Worship proposes that the following text be added to paragraph 4 of Article 6 of the abovementioned text:

“The General Assembly shall abstain from considering the candidature of such entities if their headquarters is located in a territory that is the subject of a sovereignty dispute recognized by the United Nations, or if their activity is linked to such a territory, unless the States party to the dispute are in agreement regarding the submission of the candidature.”

3. It is recalled that both the General Assembly in resolution 424(XIV) adopted at its session in Seoul/Osaka in September 2001, and the Executive Council in decision 4(LXV) taken at its session in Natal in June 2001, have expressed equivalent sentiments in the past. It is up to the General Assembly to confirm them by either mentioning them once again in its resolution approving the draft amendments to Articles 6 and 7 of the Statutes, or by including this provision in the amended text of Article 6 itself.
