(b) SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 34 OF THE STATUTES

1. At 31 August 2005, the provisions of Article 34 of the Statutes and paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules attached to the Statutes (see Annex 1) are applied to the following Members. These Members have been deprived of Member's privileges in the form of services and the right to vote in the Assembly and the Council.

2. Annex 2 to this document transmits to the General Assembly the list of Members that could be liable to suspension from the rights and privileges of membership, as provided for in Article 34 of the Statutes. This application would be effective within a period of one year from the date of the Assembly resolution noting this fact.

3. The information in Annexes 1 and 2 will enable the General Assembly to rule on this matter in accordance with resolution 217(VII).

(c) REQUESTS FOR TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM THE APPLICATION OF PARAGRAPH 13 OF THE FINANCING RULES

4. All the communications received from Members requesting temporary exemption from the provisions of paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules will be submitted to the present session for its consideration. The Council will formulate the relevant recommendations which, together with the Members' requests, will be forwarded to the Assembly in an addendum to this document so that it may adopt the appropriate resolution.

TEMPORARY EXEMPTION FROM APPLICATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 34 AND PARAGRAPH 13

- 5. The following Members submitted to the General Assembly at its fifteenth session (Beijing, China 2003) plans for the payment of their contribution arrears in instalments and requested that the provisions of paragraph 13 not be applied to them. The General Assembly agreed to grant such temporary exemption to these Members subject to the following two conditions:
 - (a) <u>immediate</u> payment of the contribution corresponding to <u>2003</u>, the year in which the Assembly agreed to suspend application of the aforementioned provisions;

(b) strict observance of the agreed plan for the settlement of arrears.

OBSERVATIONS:

- (1) **Bolivia:** The payment plan covers part of the debt. From 2003 onwards, the payment of arrears pending should have been the subject of a new agreement.
- (2) **Burundi:** Until a legal position is adopted concerning this Member's request for a temporary suspension of its full membership.
- (3) Costa Rica: Since the debt of Costa Rica is less than the amount of its assessed contributions for the past two years, the provisions of paragraph 13 are no longer applicable to it.
- (4) Iraq: Since Iraq is no longer subject to United Nations sanctions, it is now up to that country to present a payment plan for its contribution arrears to the Executive Council session preceding the General Assembly's sixteenth session at the latest. According to decision CE/DEC/(LXXIV), the Executive Council, at its seventy-fourth session held at Salvador de Bahia, Brazil, and having taken cognizance of the proposals by Italy and Nigeria, decided to transmit to the Committee on Budget and Finance for study and recommendation Iraq's and Sierra Leona's arrears in the light of the decisions that could be taken by various institutions of the United Nations system. The Committee on Budget and Finance at its 44th meeting, after studying the proposals by Italy and Nigeria to take into consideration the especially difficult situations being experienced by Full Members Iraq and Sierra Leone [CE/DEC/5(LXXIV)] and to reduce the amount of their contribution arrears, and in light of the consultation carried out regarding this matter, decided to reserve its opinion, as it was informed that the aforementioned Member States had not yet submitted any request in this regard to the United Nations.
- (5) Rep. Moldova: While a legal study is undertaken to ascertain the true date of this country's admission to WTO.
- (6) Yemen: The payment plan covers the arrears for the period 1990-1998. Once the present plan has been concluded, the payment of arrears pending (1979-1989), owed by the former People's Republic of Yemen, will be the subject of a new agreement.

ANNEX 1

ARTICLE 34 OF THE STATUTES

- 1. Article 34 of the Statutes concerning the suspension of Members provides as follows:
 - "1. If any Member is found by the Assembly to persist in a policy that is contrary to the fundamental aim of the Organization as mentioned in Article 3 of these Statutes, the Assembly may, by a resolution adopted by a majority of two-thirds of Full Members present and voting, suspend such Member from exercising the rights and enjoying the privileges of membership.
 - "2. The suspension shall remain in force until a change of such policy is recognized by the Assembly."
- 2. At its seventh session the General Assembly adopted the following resolution 217(VII) concerning the application of these provisions:

A/RES/217(VII)

Suspension of Members in arrears in the payment of statutory contributions: Article 34 of the Statutes

"The General Assembly,

"Considering decision 2(XXX) by which the Executive Council recommended the Assembly to apply Article 34 of the Statutes and consequently to suspend the Members of the Organization whose contribution arrears are equal to or exceed the contributions owed by such Members for four financial years and who have not, within six months, agreed with the Secretary-General on a payment plan for reimbursing these arrears,

"Considering document A/7/10(j) prepared by the Secretary-General pursuant to the above Executive Council decision,

"Recognizing that Article 34 of the Statutes, which provides the sanction of suspension when a Member persists in a policy that is contrary to the fundamental aim of the Organization as mentioned in Article 3 of the Statutes, becomes applicable in the case of prolonged non-payment of obligatory contributions to the Organization's budget, such an attitude clearly constituting a policy contrary to the aims of WTO,

"1. <u>Decides</u> to apply henceforward the measure of suspension provided for in Article 34 of the Statutes:

- "(a) when a Member of the Organization has accumulated contribution arrears in respect of any four financial years, which need not be consecutive, partial payment of contributions not preventing the measure of suspension being applied, and;
- "(b) when the aforementioned Member has not agreed a payment plan for the contribution arrears with the Secretary-General within a period of one year from the date of the resolution by which the Assembly noted that the measure of suspension was applicable to the Member pursuant to Article 34 of the Statutes;"
- "3. Requests the Secretary-General to apply the present resolution and to inform each session of the Executive Council concerning its application."

PARAGRAPH 13 OF THE FINANCING RULES ATTACHED TO THE STATUTES

- 3. The provisions of paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules attached to the Statutes read as follows:
 - "13. A Member which is in arrears in the payment of its financial contributions to the Organization's expenditure shall be deprived of the privileges enjoyed by the Members in the form of services and the right to vote in the Assembly and the Council if the amount of its arrears equals or exceeds the amount of the contributions due from it for the preceding two financial years. At the request of the Council, the Assembly may, however, permit such a Member to vote and to enjoy the services of the Organization if it is satisfied that the failure to pay is due to conditions beyond the control of the Member."
- 4. In this regard, at its sixth session the Assembly adopted the following resolution:

A/RES/162(VI)

"The General Assembly,

"Confirms the following provisions;

"When a Member becomes subject to the provisions of paragraph 13 of the Financing Rules and Regulation 8(7) of the Financial Regulations, the Assembly may restore that Member's right to vote and to enjoy the services of the Organization, only on an exceptional basis, when:

- "1. the Member has explained the reasons for its failure to pay in writing and has requested the restoration of its rights in writing;
- "2. the Council finds that the circumstances are beyond the Member's control;
- "3. the Council and the country concerned have agreed to the measures which should be taken in order to settle the arrears."
