BEST SUSTAINABLE HOTEL: EUROPE

1. Measure

- HLL opened it's doors in August 2021
- First full year measurement was done 8/2022
- The Co2 emissions was totally 14,1 Co2 ton
 - Electricity 3,2 ton Co2
 - Water 0,2 ton Co2
- Target to reduce above numbers by 5% in 2023 (by guest and room night)



2. Decarbonise

Actions in 2023

- Entire hotel runs on 100% wind power, thus reducing electricity consumption by:
 - Doors and windows sealant overhaul
 - Lowering room temperature while not in use
 - Installing solar panels and using heating automatization
 - Rewarding guests who arrive with public transport
 - Intensifying bog restoring project in Nuuksio national park
 - Instructing guests how to recycle and reduce water consumption



3. Regenerate

Actions in 2023:

- Bog restoration (staff)
- Alien species removal
- Installation and maintenance of birdhouses
- Defibrillator installation
- A pilot for eco-tourism holidays



4. Collaborate

Actions in 2023:

- Joint products with the Forest authorities and Haltia nature center to create new eco-friendly activities and products for guests
- Increase staff workdays in the national park with 100%
- Collaborate with stakeholders in the area to improve recycling
- Improve communication about actions and results in the decarbonizing activities (IG)
- Co-operate with Arctic Farming and install vertical farming facility in order to grow own herbs and salads
- Trench candle production (for the support of Ukraine)



5. Finance

Actions in 2023:

- Increase work days for HLL staff in Nuuksio national park
- Secure financing for solar panels
- Invest in seppo.io gamification app to educate guests in environmental practices
